

Over time, moist clay can be compromised and harden due to exposure to air making it difficult to use. Fortunately, there is an easy solution to this dilemma. To reconstitute the clay before working with it you can do the following:

- 1. Take the bags of clay you are about to use out of the box. Fill each bag with 1 cup of water. Then gather the top of the bag and tape it closed.
- 2. Place the bags (with the closed opening up) in a 5-gallon bucket and fill with water. Do not cover the top of the bag with water.
- 3. Let stand 2 3 days.
- 4. Check consistency.

The pressure from the water in the bucket forces the water in the bag to be rapidly absorbed by the clay so that it is nice and soft and ready for use.
