Before you Begin

Review all instructions before beginning assembly.


Please note that some hardware may be pre-installed


Unpack the carton the unit came in. Be sure to remove everything.

Before starting, check the parts against the parts list. Separate, identify and count all hardware parts. Assembly will be much easier if this is done first.

The following tools are required for assembly: Phillips Screwdriver, Blade Screwdriver, and Mallet/Hammer. This unit can be cleaned with a mild detergent and a damp cloth.


To assure the prompt and accurate handling of a claim in the event of damage, this unit must be packed in its original carton in the same manner as which it was shipped. Failure to do this may result in a claim denial.







It is a good idea to assemble your Refreshment Center on a carpet to avoid scratching. If this is not possible you can use the box the unit came in as a work surface. (Be sure to remove all staples!)




First, pre-assemble Top Panel (A) by inserting four Rafix Bolts (a) then screw in Magnet Catch (b) using two Wood Screws #5 x 5/8 (c).


NOTE: Nut inserts are pre-installed





Second, Pre-assemble Bottom Panel (B) by inserting four Rafix Bolts (a).





Finally, Pre-assemble both Side Panels (D) by inserting two Rafix Bolts (a) to each Side Panel.
















Reference Illustration for correct positioning of Metal Shelves () BEFORE beginning this step.


For Left Door: Attach Metal Shelf using holes where flange is facing out with two Machine Screws 1/4-20 x 1/2 (g) and secure in place with two 1/4-20 nuts (h).

Repeat procedure for other two shelves.















Attach one Handle (j) to each Door using two 1-1/4" Wood Screws (k) for each Handle.

Next, attach one Bushing (I) to hole on top and bottom of Outer Left Side Panel and Outer Right Side Panel on each Door.












Pre-assemble each Foot (gg) with one End Cap (m). Also, insert a Table Screw 1/4 - 20 x 1 (n) into two Feet.

Attach Feet without Table Screws to the Hinge Rods (aa). Next, attach two Feet with Table Screws to remaining holes on the Bottom Panel (B).


Open doors carefully and tighten all Rafix Cams on Bottom Panel.








Flip Assembly over and place four Steel Pins (o) to desired location for Adjustable Shelf (F) inside of Assembly. Position Adjustable Shelf on Steel Pins. Assembly of your unit is now complete.
