
CLIK'N'FIT® WINDOW PRIVACY SCREEN | SLAT

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION GUIDE

The Clik'n'Fit® Window Privacy Screen is quick to assemble and fast to install. Pleasefollow the instructions to ensure your screen will be installed securely and will look its best.

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TOOLS REQUIRED

- 1. Tape Measure
- 2. Hand Riveter with 3.2mm Nozzle
- 3. Electric Drill
- 4. 1/8" Drill Bit
- 5. Hex Driver



ASSEMBLY

- 1. Insert UNI 9 Locking Plugs into Slotted Box Sections if not already inserted.
- Insert slats into one of the Slotted Box and push the slat through the Locking Plug until it touches the inside edge of the Slotted Box Section.
- 3. Insert slats into the other Slotted Box, start at the top and work your way down. Keep the rail at a slight angle so it is easier to engage the Locking Plug hole. The slat will slide out from the first Slotted Box Section until it engages the Locking Plug locking point.
- 4. For Screens over 2000mm wide a pre-drilled Centre Vertical Slat (CVS)will be provided. Ensure you fully COMPRESS the screen by pulling the sides in tight. Mark the middle of the screen top and bottom and centre the CVS in place. Drill through the top and bottom holes into the horizontal slat.

IMPORTANT: only drill through the rear of the horizontal slat & not all the way through to the face (approx 12-14mm)! Put your rivets in the 2 holes to hold in place but don't pop off yet. Drill the remaining holes.

- Remove the CVS and clean away any swarf. Place the CVSback in place, insert all rivets and then pop the rivets off.
- Attach the Wall Brackets to the Slotted Box (4)
 using Self Drilling Screws Hex 10-16x16 through
 the back of the Slotted Box approximately 5mm
 from the top of the Slotted Box for each bracket.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Fully expand the panel so that locking plugs are engaged on both sides.
- 2. The distance between fixing holes is the width of the panel 30mm.
- 3. Before fixing in place, hold the completed panel up against the window to decide where you would like it placed. Mark the hole position. Place the panel against the wall and screw in the first wall screw (T17-14-14x40). Square up the panel using a level and fix the remaining three bracket locations.
- 4. **NOTE:**The window screen can be compressed 10mm to 15mm if required when fitting but it cannot be expanded in width size.
- 5. Panel is now installed.
- 6. Wash down the panel to remove any swarf.
- 7. **IMPORTANT:** Do not use touch up paint for any minor scratches as it will fade at a different rate and be very obvious.
