Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers.



Paper Prep:

- Yellow patterned paper 8 1/2" x 3 1/2" (Jenn used Flower Market- Buttercup 12x12 paper LF2744 and Scalloped Slimline with Hearts: Portrait LF2477)
- Distress White Heavystock 8" x 3" (Jenn used Small Slimline with Lift the Flaps LF2358)

Diecut the following:

- Dark pink cardstock - Henry's ABCs, LF2814 and Henry's 123s LF2815 "Berry Much !" (Jenn used Guava Cardstock LF1117)

Stamp and diecut the following images:

Berry Special LF2764 and Berry Special Lawn Cuts LF2765

- row of strawberries (qty 2)
- sign
- single strawberry
- mouse facing left holding strawberries
- mouse facing left eating a strawberry
- mouse facing right with overalls
- bee

Card Base:

- cut to 8 1/2" x 7", folded to 8 1/2" x 3 1/2"



Popped up with foam tape:
everything but the 2 left facing mice
(3L foam strips works great behind the letters)

Card 2: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers.



Paper Prep:

- Yellow patterned paper 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (Jenn used Flower Market- Buttercup 12x12 paper LF2744)
- Dark pink cardstock 3 1/4" x 4 5/8" (Jenn used Guava Cardstock LF 1117)
- Small Stitched 4 Bar Rectangles 3" x 4 3/8", LF1027 White Cardstock (Jenn used White Cardstock (Neenah Classic Crest 80 lbs Smooth Solar White)

Diecut the following:

- Dark pink cardstock - Henry's ABCs, LF2814 and Henry's 123s LF2815 "Jam !" (Jenn used Guava Cardstock LF1117)

Stamp and diecut the following images:

Berry Special LF2764 and Berry Special Lawn Cuts LF2765

- strawberry trio (qty 2)
- single strawberry
- mouse facing right with overalls
- bee
- jam jar (qty 3)
- fruit basket
- jam label
- heart
- small flower

Card Base:

- cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"



Popped up with foam tape:

- mouse
- single strawberry
- jam jars
- bee
- “jam!” letters
- (3L foam strips works great behind the letters)

Prisma glitter:

- base of wings on bee
- trace the line on the jam jar covers
- heart
- small flower
