Spiffy Speckles - Strawberry Frosting 12x12 paper, LF1862, Pesto 12x12 paper, LF1864 Vanilla Malt Cardstock, LF1576 White Cardstock (Neenah Classic Crest 80lb Smooth Solar White), LF1753 1/8" double-sided tape, LF1941 1/4" double-sided tape, LF1942 Black Licorice Ink Pad, LF868 Jet Black Ink Pad, LF1302



## Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



#### Diecut the following:

• Platform Pop-Up, LF2792

Base: cut out of Spiffy Speckles, Pesto 12x12 paper, LF1864 - qty 2 T-shaped tab: cut out of Spiffy Speckles, Pesto 12x12 paper, LF1864 - qty 3 Grass border: cut out of Spiffy Speckles, Pesto 12x12 paper, LF1864 - qty 3 Bow pieces: Spiffy Speckles - Strawberry Frosting 12x12 paper, LF1862 Ribbon band: Spiffy Speckles - Strawberry Frosting 12x12 paper, LF1862 - qty 4 Small heart: Spiffy Speckles - Strawberry Frosting 12x12 paper, LF1862 - qty 4

 Platform Pop-Up Picket Fence Wrap Around, LF3372

Fence wrap: cut out of Vanilla Malt Cardstock, LF1576 - qty 2 Stitched label: cut out of Spiffy Speckles, Pesto 12x12 paper, LF1864 Grass bunch: cut out of Spiffy Speckles, Pesto 12x12 paper, LF1864 - qty 5

#### Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Carrot 'bout You, LF3349 and Lawn Cuts, LF3350

- large carrot car
- large bunny
- cart
- straight hitch
- sign
- row of flowers qty 2

\* **note:** put the grass bunches, small heart and knot to the bow on some low-tack tap so you don't lose the small pieces.



## Card 2: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



#### **Paper Prep:**

• 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" white cardstock (Jenn will be using Distress White Heavystock)

#### **Diecut the following:**

 Stitched Garden Border, LF1618 ground: cut from Kraft Cardstock LF1747, approx 1.5" high front of carrot: cut from Fake Tan Cardstock, LF1118

back of carrot: cut from white cardstock

• Oliver's Stitched ABCs, LF325 cut from Fake Tan Cardstock, LF1118 - C R R O T

#### **Card Base:**

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

#### Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Carrot 'bout You, LF3349 and Lawn Cuts, LF3350

- large carrot car
- large bunny
- row of carrots
- single carrot qty 3

Carrot 'bout You Banner Add-On, LF3351 and Lawn Cuts, LF3352
