Project 1: Queen Bee



Lawn Fawn Stamps, Lawn Cuts, Stencil & Papers:

Hive Five Kit, LF3005
Hive Five
Hive Five Lawn Cuts
Honeycomb Stencil
Stripes 'n Sprinkles Petite Paper
Sparkle Glaze, LF2826

Other Lawn Fawn Supplies:

White Cardstock (Neenah Classic Crest 80lb Smooth Solar White), LF1753
Lemonade Ink Pad, LF1566 *
No.2 Pencil Ink Pad, LF1852 *
Black Licorice Ink Pad, LF868 **
Jet Black Ink Pad, LF1302

* we will be ink blending with these inks

** we will be stamping sentiments with this ink pad

Recommended Supplies:

Copics (specific colors listed on coloring guide pages)
Lawn Fawn Glue Tube, LF1664
1.75" round grip block with grid, LF496
2.5" round grip block with grid, LF497
3L Foam Squares
Die Cut Machine
Blender Brushes
Wendy Vecchi Make Art Stay-tion for easy stencil use
Mister bottle filled with Isopropyl Alcohol for easy stencil cleaning
Flour Sack Cloth or paper towel



Project 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers.



Paper Prep:

- Pink patterned paper 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (Jenn used a piece from the Stripes 'n Sprinkles Petite Paper included in the kit)
- White Cardstock 4" x 5 1/4" (your favorite to ink blend on)

Card Base:

- cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Hive Five and Hive Five Lawn Cuts

- daisy (qty 3)
- bee facing right
- queen bee
- hive
- banner
- speech bubble
- honey dipper
- honey pot
- short bee trail
- long bee trail (without the heart)



Project 1: Details



Popped up with foam tape:

- honey jar
- queen bee
- speech bubble
- tops of flowers

Glittered:

Sparkle Glaze, LF2826-

- crown
- shadow of bee wings
- yellow parts of flowers
- lines on hive
- a little on the honey dipper

Project 2: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers.



Paper Prep:

- White Cardstock 3" x 2 1/2" (your favorite to ink blend on)
- White Cardstock 2 1/2" x 1 1/4" (your favorite to ink blend on)

Diecut the following:

- Yellow patterned paper stitched tag (Jenn used a piece from the Stripes 'n Sprinkles Petite Paper included in the kit)
- qty 3 - White Cardstock flowers (Jenn used Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753)

Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

- bee facing front



Project 2: Details



created for lawn fawn by jenn shurkus

Popped up with foam tape:

- bee
- sentiment strips

Glittered:

Sparkle Glaze, LF2826-

- shadow of bee wings

BONUS card idea - Use the tag we created on a card! Die cut 2 extra flowers to cover the tag hole, and to add under the sentiment strips

Die cut a stitched rectangle, Jenn used Large Stitched Rectangle Stackables, LF767, 4 1/2" x 3 1/4" - blue patterned paper from the Stripes 'n Sprinkles Petite Paper included in the kit.

Adhere the tag on the stitched rectangle with foam squares

Card Base: cut to 7" x 4 7/8", folded to 3 1/2" x 4 7/8", vertical side fold



Copic Coloring Guide

You can use any coloring medium during class. Jenn will be coloring with the following Copic markers and will teach her blending tips and tricks. No matter what coloring medium you are using, these coloring guides will help with where to put the shadows, and color choice. Jenn shares more about Copic marker basics here:

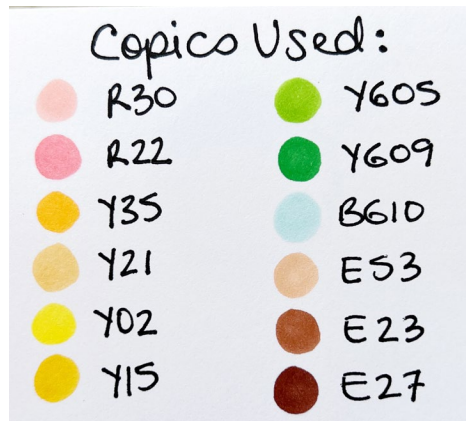
Before class TIP: using a repositionable tape/washi tape temporarily adhere your images to a strip of tape to make it easier to hold onto the images while coloring in class (shown below)

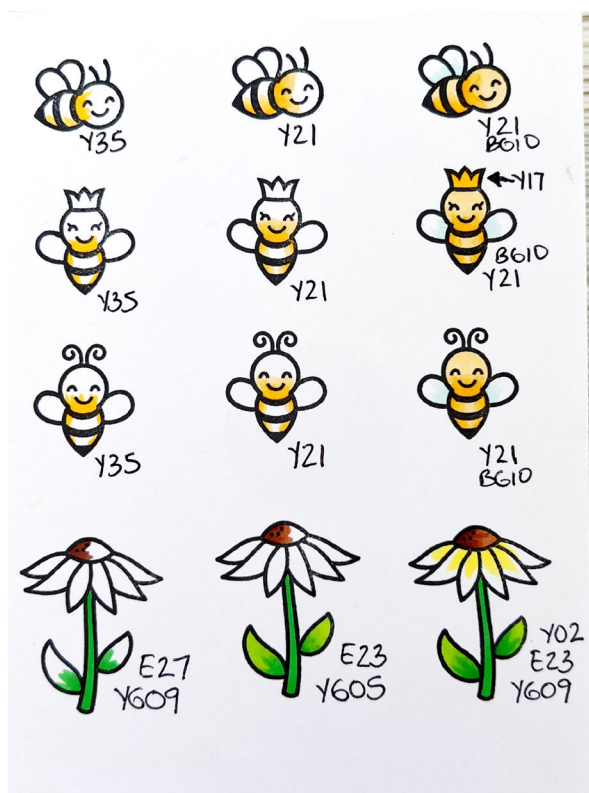
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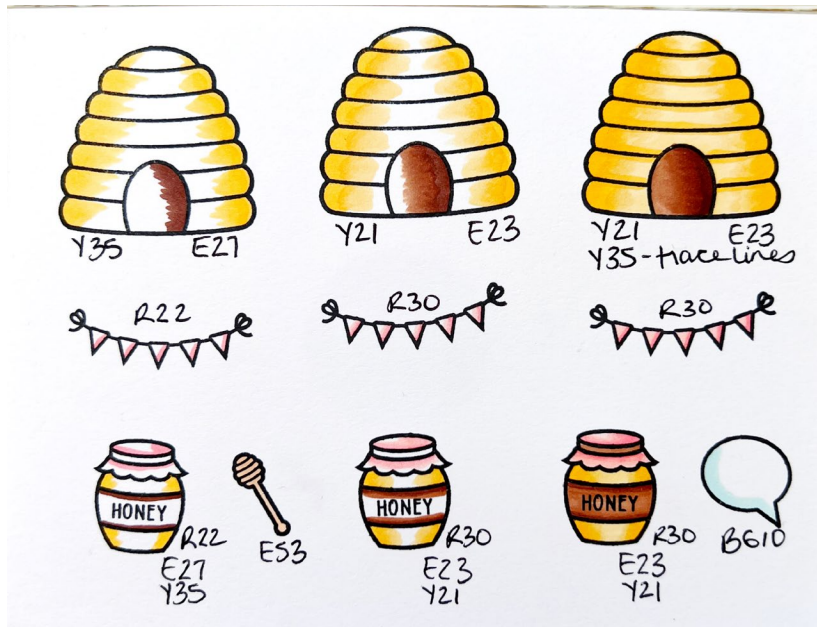
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Coloring with Copics (refer to coloring guides):

- bees wing shadow BG10
- crown Y17
- flower stem YG09
- flower leaves YG09, YG05
- flower petal shadow Y02
- flower center E27, E23



Coloring with Copics (refer to coloring guides):

- bee hive Y35, Y21
- bee hive door E27, E23
- banner R22, R30
- honey pot Y35, Y21
- honey pot label E27, E23
- honey pot cover R22, R30
- honey dipper E53
- speech bubble shadow BG10
