

Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



Paper Prep:

 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" green patterned paper (Jenn will be using Spiffy Speckles - Pesto 12x12 paper)

Diecut the following:

• Flippin' Awesome, LF2043

base: cut out of White Cardstock, LF1753 - qty 1

base: cut to the first scored section (see pic): cut out of Spiffy Speckles Pesto 12x12 paper, LF1864 - qty 1

squares: cut out of Spiffy Speckles Pesto 12x12 paper, LF1864 - qty 4

stitched squares: cut out of Knit Picky - Itchy Sweater 12x12 paper, LF2986 front side - qty 2 stitched squares: cut out of Knit Picky - Itchy Sweater 12x12 paper, LF2986 back side - qty 2 stitched rectangle: cut out of Knit Picky - Itchy Sweater 12x12 paper, LF2986 back side - qty 1

Flippin' Awesome Add-On, LF2044
 pull tab: cut out of Knit Picky - Itchy Sweater
 12x12 paper, LF2986 - qty 1
 stitched scalloped rectangle: cut out of Straw
 berry Frostings 12x12 paper, LF1862 - qty 1

Card Base:

 cut to 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", folded to 5 1/2" x 4 1/4", horizontal top fold

Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)



Card 2: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



Paper Prep:

- 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" green patterned paper (Jenn will be using Spiffy Speckles - Pesto 12x12 paper)
- approx 1/2" x 3" pink patterned paper (Jenn will be using Spiffy Speckles - Strawberry Frosting 12x12 paper) with "hope your holidays are" stamped in black ink.

Card Base:

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

Diecut the following:

 Winter Wonderland Window, LF3255 (see pics for placement on page 7)

dotted frame: cut out of Knit Picky -Itchy Sweater 12x12 paper, LF2986 snowflake frame: cut out of Sparkle Cardstock, Pixie Dust, LF1750

 Stitched Oliver's ABCs, LF325 cut out of Spiffy Speckles - Strawberry Frostings 12x12 paper, LF1862 - M E R R Y

Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

full stocking

Merry Mice, LF2684 and Lawn Cuts LF2685

- mouse facing right
- big present
- small present

Card 2: details



Glittered:

Prisma Glitter, LF1535 - Quickie Glue Pen, LF2551 shadow on the scarf shadow on berries white bows on presents white part of candy cane trace scallop line on stocking bottom parts of the MERRY letters



Popped up with foam squares: everything except the pine cone and red present








Tips for die-cutting the Winter Wonderland Window:

center the dotted frame on 4.25" x 5.5" patterned paper, secure with low tack tape and then diecut.

use that piece to then center/place the snowflake frame on 4.25" x 5.5" sparkle cardstock, secure with low tack tape and then die-cut

* Jenn didn't snip her snowflakes out of the center so that it would die-cut them at the same time and she can use them on another project.




