Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



Paper Prep:

- 4.25" x 5.5" red cardstock (Jenn will use Chili Pepper Cardstock)
- 4.25" x 5.5" white cardstock for ink blending (Jenn will use Distress White Heavystock)

Card Base:

- cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

I Heart Pandas, LF3596 and Lawn Cuts LF3597

- panda duo
- large bamboo
- small bamboo
- left bamboo branch
- right bamboo branch
- heart
- lady bug
- butterfly with closed wings

Popped up with foam squares:

pandas, small bamboo, ladybug, butterfly

Glittered with Prisma Glitter, LF1535 and Quickie Glue Pen, LF2551:

tips of leaves

light part of heart, butterfly wings, ladybug

White Gel Pen LF1033 Detail:

cheeks on pandas, ladybug

Black Glaze Pen LF3287 Detail:

spots on ladybug, body of butterfly

Card 2: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



Paper Prep:

- 4.25" x 5.5" red cardstock (Jenn will use Chili Pepper Cardstock)
- 4.25" x 5.5" white cardstock for ink blending (Jenn will use Distress White Heavystock)

Card Base:

- cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

Stamp the following images onto a 4.25" x 5.5" panel:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

We will die-cut during class after we use the coloring stencils

I Heart Pandas, LF3596 and Lawn Cuts LF3597

- panda facing right
- panda holding bamboo
- large bamboo
- small bamboo - qty 2
- butterfly with open wings

Card 2: details



Popped up with foam squares:

pandas
butterfly

Glittered with Prisma Glitter, LF1535 and Quickie Glue Pen, LF2551:

left side of bamboo stalks
right side of bamboo in panda's hand
light part of butterfly wings

White Gel Pen LF1033 Detail:

cheeks on pandas



Copic Coloring Guide

You can use any coloring medium during class. Jenn will be coloring with the following Copic markers and will teach her blending tips and tricks. No matter what coloring medium you are using, these coloring guides will help with where to put the shadows, and color choice. Jenn shares more about Copic marker basics here: www.shurk.us/copic101 she even has an online Copic class where you can learn even more! www.shurk.us/class-copic101

Before class TIP: using a low tack tape/washi tape temporarily adhere your images to a strip of tape to make it easier to hold onto the images while coloring in class (shown below)

Jenn also attached the smaller die-cut pieces out of white cardstock to make coloring easier

Note: all images may not be shown, just those that are smaller that we will be coloring, refer to the prep for a full list



We will create one card coloring with alcohol based markers, and then create the other card using the coloring stencils and Lawn Fawn ink pads.




bamboo branch: YG67, YG05, YG01
pandas E41, R20
heart R35, RV13
butterfly R35, RV13
ladybug R35, RV13, T4, T2, R20
