### Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and white layers on cards. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers.



- Red Cardstock 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (Jenn used Chili Pepper LF1116)
- Distress White Heavystock 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (see instructions on page 8 to stencil before class if you would like)
- White cardstock 2 1/2" x 3 7/8" (Jenn used Large Stitched 4 bar rectangles, LF1026)

#### Card base

• (1) 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"

bows on all 3 presents lights star/ tree topper


ALL Card 2: prep



Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and white layers on cards. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markerss



- Gold Cardstock 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (Jenn used Metallic Cardstock - Gold, LF2456)
- Distress White Heavystock 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (see instructions to stencil before class)
- White cardstock 1 1/2" high x 5 1/2" (Jenn used Stitched Hillside Borders, LF772 - see below)
- White cardstock 2 1/4" high and 5 1/2" (Jenn used Stitched Hillside Borders, LF772 - see below)



Card base

• (1) 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"

Stamp and diecut the following images:

Joy To All, Stamps LF2668 and Lawn Cuts, LF2669

- Christmas tree
- small present
- round present
- star/tree topper
- dog bowl with gingerbread

Furry and Bright, Stamps LF2670 and Lawn Cuts, LF2671

- dog on hind legs
- running dog
- dog facing front
- bone present
- antler hat qty 2
- string of lights qty 2
- speech bubble



## Card 1: background stencil prep

Before class, if you would like to create your backgrounds, you can follow these instructions. Jenn will also go over these steps during the Create with Us class so no worries if you want to wait & learn that way.



1. on Distress White Heavystock 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" - using one of the snowflake stencils, ink blend with Bubblegum ink.

Keep track where the lawn fawn words are on the stencil, this will help you line up the 2nd stencil. I kept mine at the bottom center.



2. Layer the second snowflake stencil to fill in the empty spaces, remember to have the lawn fawn words in the same spot as the first stencil, this will help know the positioning.

Ink blend with Lobster ink.



3. Clean the Lobster ink off the stencil, then put it back in place. Spread fairy dust stencil paste through the stencil with a palette knife.

# Card 1: background stencil prep

Before class, if you would like to create your backgrounds, you can follow these instructions. Jenn will also go over these steps during the Create with Us class so no worries if you want to wait & learn that way.



4. With the palette knife, spread the paste evenly covering the entire stencil.



5. Fairy dust stencil paste dries translucent with a sparkle and raised texture, so the Lobster ink will still show through.



# Card 2: background stencil prep

Before class, if you would like to create your backgrounds, you can follow these instructions. Jenn will also go over these steps during the Create with Us class so no worries if you want to wait & learn that way.



1. on Distress White Heavystock 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" - using one of the snowflake stencils, ink blend with Mermaid ink.

Keep track where the lawn fawn words are on the stencil, this will help you line up the 2nd stencil. I kept mine at the bottom center.



2. You will see there are spaces in your background where the second stencil will fill in.



3. Layer the second snowflake stencil to fill in the empty spaces, remember to have the lawn fawn words in the same spot as the first stencil, this will help know the positioning.

4. Spread fairy dust stencil paste through the stencil with a palette knife.



5. Fairy dust stencil paste dries translucent with a sparkle and raised texture, so this will add a pretty sparkle to the background.

Before class TIP: using a repostionable tape/washi tape temporarily adhere your images to a strip of tape to make it easier to hold onto the images while coloring in class (shown below)




