

# Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



#### Paper Prep:

• 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" white cardstock for ink blending (Jenn will be using Distress White Heavystock)

#### Card Base:

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

#### Diecut the following:

Henry's ABCs, LF2814 cut out of white cardstock for ink blending (Jenn will be using Distress White Heavystock)- P R I C K L E

#### Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Porcu-pine for You, LF3299 and Lawn Cuts, LF3300



Popped up with foam squares: acorns stamped hearts porcupines




Popped up with foam strips: P R I C K L E letters



#### **Paper Prep:**

• 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" white cardstock for ink blending (Jenn will be using Distress White Heavystock)

#### Card Base:

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

#### Diecut the following:

Henry's ABCs, LF2814 cut out of Sparkle Cardstock, Pixie Dust, LF1750- Q U I L L

#### Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)




