Card Base:

cut to 7" x 8.5", folded to 3.5" x 8.5"

Popped up with foam tape:

the bunny on a scooter, and the fox on a scooter. The stitched rectangle on the paid paper

Glittered

Prisma glitter: polka dots and fringe on the party hat, the pink and green party hat, the bow on the present, and the balloons

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Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/diecut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and white layers on cards. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that.



- multi colored plaid patterned paper, Perfectly Plaid Remix- Jessica Remix, LF2488 - the diagonal stripe side 3.5" x 8.5"
- White cardstock, LF1753, stitched or not 8" x 3" - Jenn used Small Slimline with Lift the Flaps, LF2358
- road side bottom layer- white cardstock,
 LF1753 using Slimline Road Border, LF2569
- road side top layer- black cardstock, LF1125 using Slimline Road Border, LF2569

Card base

• (1) 7" x 8.5", folded to 3.5" x 8.5"

All images can be stamped in black ink that works with the medium you will be coloring with. If coloring with Copic Markers Jenn recommends Jet Black Lawn Fawn Ink.

Cloudy Stencil, LF2250 Slimline Grassy Hillside Stencils, LF2578 Spiffy Speckles-Pesto, LF1864 Perfectly Plaid Remix- Kristin Remix, LF2485 Shimmer Cardstock- Pastel, LF2180 White Cardstock (Neenah Classic Crest 80lb Smooth Solar White), LF1753 Merman Ink Pad, LF1088* Freshly Cut Grass Ink Pad, LF863* Black Licorice Ink Pad, LF868 Jet Black Ink Pad, LF1302

Card Base:

cut to 7" x 8.5", folded to 3.5" x 8.5"

Popped up with foam tape:

The mouse on the scooter, the heads of the fox and bunny, the "puffs" coming off the scooters The stitched rectangle on the plaid paper

*we will not be stamping with this ink so you can substitute these for Distress Inks, or any other brand water-based dye inks you may have.

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Card 2: prep

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Card 2: prep continued







- multi colored plaid patterned paper, Perfectly Plaid Remix- Kristin Remix, LF2485 - the diagonal stripe side 3.5" x 8.5"
- White cardstock, LF1753, stitched or not 8" x 3" - Jenn used Small Slimline with Lift the Flaps, LF2358
- green patterned paper, Spiffy Speckles-Pesto, LF1864 - cut to 3 sizes 1.5" high, 2.25" high, and 3.5" high. Width of each should be at least 3.5". Then cut stitched hillsides out of each piece, see photo, be sure to put the hillside at the very top of the patterned paper. Then using the slimline stitched rectangle from Small Slimline with Lift the Flaps, LF2358 and cut the hillsides so there will be stitching on the sides, and stitching on the bottom of the 1.5" high hillside. See photo.
- White cardstock stitched or not 4" x 5.25"-Jenn used the largest die in the Outside In Stitched Rectangle Stackables. LF1442
- 3 small, and 3 medium hearts from Hearts and Stars Skinny Tag LF2572 cut out of Shimmer Cardstock- Pastel, LF2180

All images can be stamped in black ink that works with the medium you will be coloring with. If coloring with Copic Markers Jenn recommends Jet Black Lawn Fawn Ink.




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Copic Coloring Guide

You can use any coloring medium during class. These are the Copic Markers Jenn will be using, and teaching blending with. No matter what coloring medium you are using, these coloring guides will help with where to put the shadows, and color choice.

Coloring with Copics (refer to coloring guides):

E00, E02 bunny YR27, YR14 fox RV10 nose, inside ears, cheeks


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


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Coloring with Copics (refer to coloring guides):

W6, W4 mice RV10 inside ears, nose RV13, RV21 pink helmet, pink balloon YG17, YG23 green helmet, green balloon BG05, BG02 blue balloon BG10 trace inner of "puff"

Coloring with Copics (refer to coloring guides):

BG05, BG02 scooter W4 metal of scooter
