

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Card 1: prep



Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



Paper Prep:

• 3/4" x 2 1/2" Storm Cloud Cardstock, LF1273

Diecut the following:

- "SEW" using Henry's ABCs LF2814 cut out of Storm Cloud Cardstock, LF1273
- 4" x 5 1/4" Spiffy Speckles Seafoam paper, LF1865. Jenn used Outside In Stitched Rectangle Stackables, LF1442
- 4" x 1 3/4" Watercolor Wishes Lucky Penny, LF1349. Jenn then used Outside In Stitched Rectangle Stackables, LF1442 to add stitching to the bottom and two sides.

Card Base:

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Sew Very Mice, LF3061 and Lawn Cuts, LF3062

- right facing mouse
- right facing mouse with arm in the air
- sitting mouse with thimble
- spool of thread
- needle and thread
- scissors

How You Bean?, LF1325 and Lawn Cuts, LF1326

- jar
- lid

How You Bean? Buttons Add-On, LF3063 and Lawn Cuts, LF3064

- button qty 3
- cluster of buttons into the jar

Sewn With Love, LF1309 and Lawn Cuts LF1310

pin cushion

Glittered:


Prisma Glitter, LF1535- Quickie Glue Pen, LF2551 highlight on all the buttons top shadow lines of the pin cushion

White Gel Pen:

little dots on the rosy cheeks of the mice

Popped up with foam squares and strips:

everything except for the pink button on the left and teal button on the right of the jar

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Card 2: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



Diecut the following:

- 4" x 5 1/4" Stripes 'n Sprinkles Petite Paper Pack, LF2921Jenn used yellow stripes and Outside In Stitched Rectangle Stackables, LF1442
- 5 1/4" x 1 1/2" Watercolor Wishes Lucky Penny, LF1349. Jenn then used Outside In Stitched Rectangle Stackables, LF1442 to add stitching to the bottom and two sides.

Card Base:

 cut to 8 1/2" x 5 1/2", folded to 5 1/2"x 4 1/4", horizontal top fold

Stamp and diecut the following images:


(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Sew Very Mice, LF3061 and Lawn Cuts, LF3062

- right facing mouse with arm in the air
- mouse holding an embroidery hoop
- mouse stitching on an embroidery hoop
- spool of thread qty 3
- scissors
- thimble
- spool of ribbon
- small button

Sewn With Love, LF1309 and Lawn Cuts LF1310

- sewing machine
- jar of buttons
- button atv 2



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Card 2: details






Glittered:

Prisma Glitter, LF1535 - Quickie Glue Pen, LF2551 light part of the buttons light part of button label trim of sewing machine light part of dial on the sewing machine bottom inner line on hoop with heart bottom inner line and crease lines on hoop being sewn on

Popped up with foam squares & foam strips:

both mice holding the hoops, spool of ribbon and teal spools of thread, scissors, mouse holding left arm up, sewing machine, small button





Copic Coloring Guide

You can use any coloring medium during class. Jenn will be coloring with the following Copic markers and will teach her blending tips and tricks. No matter what coloring medium you are using, these coloring guides will help with where to put the shadows, and color choice. Jenn shares more about Copic marker basics here:

Before class TIP: using a repostionable tape/washi tape temporarily adhere your images to a strip of tape to make it easier to hold onto the images while coloring in class (shown below)






thimble T6, T4, T2


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
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Coloring with Copics (refer to coloring guides):

teal buttons BG13, BG11, T4 pink buttons R85, R81, T4 wooden part of spool E33, E21 pink spool R81, R85 teal spool BG11, BG13 thimble T6, T4, T2 pink scissors R85, R81, T6, T2 pin cushion R85, R81, R83 pin tops BG13




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
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Coloring with Copics (refer to coloring guides):

teal buttons BG13, BG11, T4
pink buttons R85, R81, T4
spool of ribbon BG13, BG11, E21
teal scissors BG13, BG11, T6, T2
jar of buttons label and lid R85, R83, R81
buttons in the jar BG11, BG13
inner line of jar BG10
sewing machine R85, R83, R81, T4, T2
jar lid T6, T4, T2, T8
inner line of large jar BG10



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
