Veggie Happy, LF3340 Veggie Happy Lawn Cuts, LF3341 Stitched Garden Veggies, LF3373 Stitched Root Veggies, LF3374 Harvest Crate, LF3247 Everyday Sentiment Banners, LF1139

Other Lawn Fawn Supplies:

Spring Blossoms Background Stencils, LF2821 White Cardstock (Neenah Classic Crest 80lb Smooth Solar White), LF1753 Celery Stick Ink Pad, LF929 Mermaid Ink Pad, LF864 Black Licorice Ink Pad, LF868 Jet Black Ink Pad, LF1302

Copics (specific colors listed on coloring guide pages) Distress White Heavystock, LF3041 Distress Watercolor Cardstock, LF2759 Distress Watercolor Pencils (see swatches with the coloring guides) Paint Brush, LF3282 Container for water Make Art Stay-tion, LF2548 Lawn Fawn Glue Tube, LF1664 Stamping platform or a larger acrylic block like 3" x 6" LF1044 3L Foam Squares, LF886 Low tack tape, LF1037 Die Cut Machine



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Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



Paper Prep:

 4.25" x 5.5" white cardstock for ink blending (Jenn will use Distress White Heavystock)

Die-cut the following out of Watercolor Cardstock:

(Jenn will use Distress Watercolor Cardstock)

Tip: Die cut extras! And die cut some from both the smooth side and the textured side of watercolor cardstock so you can play

- Stitched Garden Veggies, LF3373 Pepper, and stem Tomato, and leaves Cauliflower, and leaves
- Stitched Root Veggies, LF3374 Turnip, and leaves Beet, and leaves Carrot, and leaves
- Harvest Crate, LF3247 crate board - qty 3 post sign

Card Base:

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

Die-cut the following out of white cardstock

• Everyday Sentiment Banners, LF1139, 3/8" x 4", and stamp whatever sentiment you choose

Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Veggie Happy, LF3340 and Lawn Cuts, LF3341

- mouse kneeling, facing right
- mouse standing, facing left

Popped up with foam squares:

everything except for the banner, which was attached across all the veggies with Lawn Fawn Glue Tube



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Card 2: prep

Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



Paper Prep:

• 4.25" x 5.5" white cardstock for ink blending (Jenn will use Distress White Heavystock)

Die-cut the following out of Watercolor Cardstock: (Jenn will use Distress Watercolor Cardstock)

Tip: Die cut extras! And die cut some from both the smooth side and the textured side of watercolor cardstock so you can play

- Stitched Garden Veggies, LF3373 Lettuce, and stem Cauliflower, and leaves
- Stitched Root Veggies, LF3374 Turnip, and leaves Onion, and leaves Carrot, and leaves
- Stitched Garden Border, LF1618 approx 2" high x 4.25" wide

Card Base:

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Veggie Happy, LF3340 and Lawn Cuts, LF3341

- mouse kneeling, facing right
- mouse standing, facing left

All the Speech Bubbles, LF3359 and Lawn Cuts, LF3360

- trio of speech bubbles
- oval speech bubble pointing right
- circle speech bubble pointing down

stamp sentiments in the speech bubbles. Jenn used ones from Veggie Happy, LF3340 and Veggie Happy Add-On, LF3342

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Copic Coloring Guide

You can use any coloring medium during class. Jenn will be coloring with the following Copic markers and will teach her blending tips and tricks. No matter what coloring medium you are using, these coloring guides will help with where to put the shadows, and color choice. 
Before class TIP: using a low tack tape/washi tape temporarily adhere your images to a strip of tape to make it easier to hold onto the images while coloring in class (shown below) Jenn also attached the smaller die-cut pieces out of Distress Watercolor Cardstock to make watercoloring easier

Note: all images may not be shown, just those that are smaller that we will be coloring, refer to the prep for a full list

mice E43, E41, R30 hats E29, E25 center of flower R30 aprons E25, E21 overalls E25, E21 rake E29, W6, W4

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

Distress Watercolor Pencils Used:

Seedless Preserves Picked Raspberry Barn Door Fired Brick Rusty Hinge Wild Honey Fossilized Amber Mustard Seed Twisted Citron Mowed Lawn Peeled Paint Forest Moss Antique Linen Vintage Photo Tea Dye Gathered Twigs Ground Espresso



Note: If you don't own Distress Watercolor Pencils, you can watercolor with either Distress Ink Pads or Distress Oxide Ink Pads. Your results will look different depending on which coloring medium you choose as you can see above.
