# Card 1: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



### **Paper Prep:**

- From the Stripes 'n Sprinkles Petite Paper Pack, LF2921 cut the red stripes patterned paper and teal sprinkles paper to be 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"
- On white cardstock approx 3 1/4" x 1/2" stamp "Have a Wheely Great Day!" with Black Licorice Ink Pad, LF868

### Diecut the following:

 "GREAT" using Henry's ABCs LF2814 cut out of white cardstock LF1753

### Card Base:

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

# Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Prisma Glitter, LF1535- Quickie Glue Pen, LF2551 shadow on hot air balloon, hearts, awning on ticket booth

bottom and right sides of clouds highlights on tickets inner strip on ferris wheel carriages shadow of hearts

# Popped up with foam squares and strips:

everything except for the tickets on the hot air balloon, the heart on the hot air balloon and ticket booth

# Card 2: prep

Before class, it will be helpful if you have the following pieces stamped/die-cut etc. Jenn used Neenah Classic Crest Cover, Solar White 80#, Super Smooth for Copic coloring, card bases, and most white layers on cards unless otherwise noted. Lawn Fawn white cardstock item LF1753 is just that. Jenn also used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink pad item LF1302 to stamp her images as she will be coloring with Copic markers which are alcohol based.



### **Paper Prep:**

- From the Stripes 'n Sprinkles Petite Paper Pack, LF2921 cut the yellow sprinkles paper to be 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"
- 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Distress White Heavystock

### Diecut the following:

 From the Stripes 'n Sprinkles Petite Paper Pack, LF2921 cut a sentiment banner 2 3/4" x 3/8" from Extra Sentiment Banners, LF1140 and the red stripe paper. Keep the piece you cut it out from.

### **Card Base:**

 cut to 4 1/4" x 11", folded to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", vertical top fold

### Stamp and diecut the following images:

(Jenn used Lawn Fawn Jet Black ink LF1302 that works with alcohol based markers and 80# Neenah cardstock which Lawn Fawn White Cardstock LF1753 is)

Fly High, LF3069 and Lawn Cuts, LF3070

- large hot air balloon
- large heart
- elephant
- mouse looking up
- small mouse
- large banners




### Glittered:

Prisma Glitter, LF1535 - Quickie Glue Pen, LF2551 a few clouds, on the right side light part of the banner shadow of large heart

# Popped up with foam squares & foam strips:

everything but the heart, sentiment banner, banner and mouse in the balloon







