
ADVANCED OPERATION

VTX• From Play Mode Screen, Hole Layout Screen, and Hazard Screen, tap button to switch to Green View Screen. The shape of the green rotates with your angle

of approach, giving you're the real distances to center of the green. • From Green View Screen, tap button 🗂 or press Voice button to return to the previous screer









• You can place the pin anywhere on the green from Green View Screen by tapping the pin to the preferred location. As the pin moves, the distance will change accordingly.

• Tap button () to toggle on or off the feature of Pin Tracker.

• The Pin Tracker shows you the direction to the pin even when the green is out of sight.

Shot Distance

- From Play Mode Screen or Hazard Screen, tap button 🔎 to switch to Shot
- Distance Scree Tap button to start measuring your shot distance. The Shot Distance Screen will return to the previous screen by tapping button \frown or swiping the screen
- Once you have reached your ball, switch to Shot Distance Screen and tap button no to finish measuring and view the shot distance.

Approaching to the Green

• The screen changes to the screen shown to the left automatically from Play Mode when the golfer is within 20 yards of the center of the green.

• The device will automatically advance to the next hole as you play through

* In rare instances it may be necessary to manually advance to the next hole.

Manual Hole Selection • From Play Mode Screen or Hole Layout Screen, you can change from current

Charging the Battery

- Connect the device to a power outlet using the included cable and the USB wall charger.
- You can also charge your device by connecting the included cable to your computer. Do not use a quick charger ac adapter to charge
- the device. Doing so may cause damage and voice the warranty. Ac adapters should not exceed 5.0V. Check your ac adapter prior to charging.

* Pressing "Data Sync" button should be discouraged during charging. Pressing the button may result in a slower charge or stop the charging altogether. · After fully charging the device, disconnect it from the USB Cable.

Unplug the USB power adapter from the electric socket.

Battery Charging Tips and Precautions

- If there is sweat or liquid on the USB port, corrosion may occur on the USB port. Clean the USB port before charging the battery.
- The battery is completely drained, the device cannot be turned on. immediately when the charging cradle is connected. Allow a depleted battery to charge for a few minutes before turning the device on.
- When the battery is charged in a high temperature room such as inside a car during the summer, the device may heat up and it can cause the battery to explode or deform the device.



- Press and hold Voice button to hear your distance to the front and back of Hole Layou

• From Hole Layout Screen, the device shows the current hole view you are playing.



Touchpoint Indicator

• When you tap the screen on Hole Layout Screen, you will see an indicator (1) that now gives you the distance (2) to that point and also will display the distance (3) from the targeted location to the center of the green.



• From Play Mode Screen, you will be able to alternate the screens A and B shown below by tapping any point on the screen.


