- 1 tsp. (5 ml) Jojoba Oil, Fractionated Coconut Oil, or Sweet Almond Oil
- ½ oz. (5 ml) Roll-on Bottle

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Add all ingredients in the order listed to your roll-on bottle.
- 2. To use, roll onto blemish areas of your skin once a day as needed.

KOOL-AID[®] LIP BALM (shown on previous page)

INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES:

- 6 g (approx 4 tsp.) Beeswax
- 10 g (approx 4 Tbsp.) Cocoa Butter (3–3 ½ wafers)
- 3 Tbsp. Jojoba Oil
- 1 tsp. (5 ml) honey
- 10-20 drops peppermint essential oil (optional)
- ½-¾ tsp. flavored drink mix, such as Kool-Aid® (strawberry and cherry flavors work well with the peppermint essential oil, and they give a great red color)
- Hot water (just enough to make a thick paste with the drink mix)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Using a kitchen scale, measure out the beeswax and cocoa butter, and place in a double boiler. (Note: you can create a double boiler by placing ingredients in a heat-proof glass dish and placing the dish in a water-filled pan.) Heat over low heat until melted.
- 2. Meanwhile, place drink mix in a glass dish, and add just enough hot water to make a paste.
- 3. Once the beeswax and cocoa butter are melted, add jojoba oil and honey, and keep warming until everything is melted. Let cool slightly, and stir in essential oil if desired.
- 4. Add oil mixture to drink mix, and stir/mash with the back of a spoon until it is thoroughly combined.
- 5. Place lip balm in a zip-top bag, and snip off a small hole in a corner with scissors. Squeeze the lip balm into the containers by twisting the bag and squeezing down. Tap the container against a hard surface to help it move to the bottom of the container. Continue until the containers are full.
- 6. Place containers in fridge until the lip balm has fully cooled.

Note: If you want to make multiple flavors, just prep your drink mix in separate bowls, and only use $\frac{1}{8}$ – $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. per dish. Then stir in $\frac{1}{2}$ –1 Tbsp. (7.5–15 ml) of the oil mixture. This should fill 1 Lip Gloss Container or 2 Lip Balm Dispensers.

FUN & FRUITY PERFUME ROLL-ON BLEND

INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES:

- 1 drop cedarwood essential oil
- 1 drop bergamot essential oil
- 2 drops grapefruit essential oil
- 2 drops orange essential oil
- 2 drops tangerine essential oil
- 2 tsp. (10 ml) carrier oil (such as Fractionated Coconut Oil, Sweet Almond Oil, or Jojoba Oil)
- ½ oz. (10 ml) roll-on bottle

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Add essential oils in order to the roll-on bottle, and fill the rest of the bottle with carrier oil.
- 2. Shake gently to combine.
- 3. Allow to sit for 24 hours, if possible, for oils to mix before using.
- 4. To use, apply to wrists and behind ears.

EYEBROW AND EYELASH GROWTH OIL

INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES:

- 1 Tbsp. (12 g) Coconut Oil, melted
- 1 Tbsp. (15 ml) Sweet Almond Oil
- 1 Tbsp. (15 ml) castor oil
- 8–10 drops Vitamin E Oil
- 2 drops lavender essential oil (optional)*
- 2 drops rosemary essential oil (optional)*
- 2 oz. glass bottle
- ½ oz. (10 ml) roll-on bottle (Item #9158) for easy application

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Mix together all ingredients in a 2 oz. glass bottle.
- To use, apply every night with a clean mascara brush or cotton swab. Or transfer mixture to a roll-on bottle, and apply by rolling on to eyebrows and lashline.

*Note: Do not include essential oils if using this mixture on your eyelashes.

BROWN SUGAR LIP SCRUB (shown on previous page) Time: 3 minutes Difficulty: Easy

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 Tbsp. (38 g) brown sugar
- 1 Tbsp. (12 g) Coconut Oil
- 1–2 drops peppermint essential oil or other desired essential oil
- 2 oz. Glass Salve Jar

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Mix together all ingredients, and transfer to a 2 oz. Glass Salve Jar.
- 2. To use, place a small amount on the lips, and rub lips together for a couple minutes. Finish by rinsing lips with water.

Our hole punch is the perfect size for our sample vials (both $\frac{5}{8}$ dram and $\frac{1}{4}$ dram) to fit through. When sharing essential oils, it's easy to lose those tiny vials of oils. If you attach them to a card full of information, your recipients can keep track of both the helpful information and the oils.

Diffusing essential oils is a great way to benefit from the aromatherapy and create warm, inviting aromas in any space.

ESSENTIAL OIL-INFUSED POTPOURRI

Time: 5 minutes Difficulty: Easy

INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES:

- Potpourri ingredients (such as cinnamon sticks, vanilla beans, dried apple slices, dried orange peels, bay leaves, candied ginger, whole nutmeg, whole cloves, whole allspice, cardamom seeds, and star anise)
- Essential oils (such as cinnamon, orange, ginger, vetiver, clove, cardamom, or holiday-scented blend)
- Containers such as glass salve jars, mason jars, or PET jars

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Cut up bigger items such as cinnamon sticks, vanilla beans, dried apple slices, bay leaves, candied ginger, etc. as needed to fit in your containers.
- 2. Add 3-5 drops of desired essential oil(s) on top of the potpourri.
- 3. To use, simply leave the lid off of the container to enjoy the delightful aromas! Add a few drops of essential oil every couple weeks or as needed. You can also put the ingredients in a pot full of simmering water to spread the smell throughout the house.

Note: To gift, make sure contents fit inside the container. Screw the lid on, and decorate with ribbon, twine, or a gift tag. You can even include a small sample bottle filled with essential oil so your gift recipients can recharge their potpourri.



Yield: 8 oz. (240 ml) Time: 3 minutes Difficulty: Easy

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 Tbsp. (30 ml) white vinegar
- 2 Tbsp. (30 ml) rubbing alcohol
- 1½ tsp. (4 g) cornstarch (This is what makes it streak-free!)
- 8-10 drops citrus essential oil (lemon, lime, grapefruit, etc.)
- ³/₄ cup (180 ml) water
- 8 oz. Glass Spray Bottle

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Mix together all ingredients except water in the spray bottle.
- 2. Screw on the spray top, and shake to combine.
- 3. Unscrew the spray top, and fill the rest of the bottle with water.
- 4. Screw on the spray top, and shake to combine.

HOMEMADE FOAMING HAND SOAP WITH ESSENTIAL OILS (shown on previous page)

Yield: 8 oz. (240 ml) Time: 2 minutes Difficulty: Easy

INGREDIENTS:

- $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ cup (60–80 ml) Castile Soap
- ²/₃ cup (160 ml) water (distilled or boiled is best, but tap water will also work)
- 10–12 drops essential oil of choice
- 8 oz. Bottle with Foamer Pump

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Simply mix the castile soap and essential oil in the foamer bottle.
- 2. Fill the remainder of the bottle with water (only fill to about $1\frac{1}{2}$ " [4 cm] from the top to save room for the foamer pump), and screw the lid on.
- 3. Feel free to wash your hands immediately and enjoy your homemade foaming soap!

EXTRA IDEAS

- Turn this into a face wash by using only ¼ cup (60 ml) castile soap, adding 5 drops melaleuca essential oil, and filling the rest up with water.
- Add some decorations such as ribbons or snowflakes to make a fun gift.

HOMEMADE CARAMEL SAUCE

Ingredients:

- ½ cup (120 ml) light corn syrup
- ½ cup (100 g) sugar
- 3 Tbsp. (43 g) butter
- ½ cup (120 ml) heavy cream
- 1 toothpick cinnamon essential oil

Instructions:

- 1. In a medium pan, heat corn syrup over medium heat.
- 2. Once corn syrup is heated through (bubbling), add sugar, and stir until well mixed.
- 3. Let syrup cook without stirring until it is a golden color.
- 4. Remove syrup from heat, and add butter. Stir until well mixed.
- 5. Slowly add cream while continuously stirring to blend. Stir in essential oil.

3-MINUTE FUDGE

Ingredients:

- 1 can (14 oz./396 g) sweetened condensed milk
- 2 cups (12 oz./340 g) semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 tsp. (5 ml) vanilla extract
- 5 drops essential oil of choice

Instructions:

- 1. Butter a square pan, and line with parchment paper. Set aside.
- 2. In a microwave-safe bowl, heat chocolate chips and sweetened condensed milk for 1 minute on high.
- 3. Remove from microwave, and let sit 1 minute.
- 4. Stir to combine until the chocolate chips are completely melted and the mixture is smooth. Stir in vanilla extract.
- 5. Pour fudge into prepared pan. Let cool all the way through before cutting (to speed up this process, you can place fudge in the refrigerator for 1 hour). Enjoy!

Essential oil recommendations: peppermint, orange

Note: Store leftovers in an airtight container. This fudge does not need to be refrigerated.

BUBBLY BATH SALTS Servings: 4–6 Time: 10 minutes active; 24 hours inactive Difficulty: Easy INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES: 1 cup (240 g) Epsom Salt 2 Tbsp. (30 ml) unscented body wash or bubble bath 1/2 tsp. (2.5 ml) Jojoba Oil 5 drops essential oil Food coloring (optional) 16 oz. PET Jar

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Mix all ingredients in a glass bowl.
- 2. Cover a cookie sheet with parchment paper.
- 3. Spread the mixture out on the cookie sheet, and let dry for 24 hours. Stir every few hours or so to make sure the mixture dries evenly and doesn't stick together.
- 4. Once fully dry, break up any large chunks, and pour into the 16 oz. PET jar.
- 5. To use, place $\frac{1}{4}$ cup (\sim 60 g) of bath salts in the bathtub as it is filling with water.

LUXURY BATH BOMBS

Yield: 6–9 bath bombs Time: 20 minutes active; 12 hours inactive Difficulty: Easy

INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES:

- $\frac{2}{3}$ cup (147 g) baking soda
- ½ cup (56 g) cornstarch
- ½ cup (80 g) Epsom Salt
- 1/3 cup (133 g) citric acid
- 2 tsp. (10 ml) water
- 2 tsp. (8 g) Coconut Oil
- 10–20 drops essential oil
- Spray bottle with water

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Combine dry ingredients in a medium bowl and the wet ingredients in a small bowl.
- 2. Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients, and mix well with a whisk. The mixture will bubble just a bit and begin to clump together. After mixing a little with the whisk, work the mixture with your fingers. Mix and blend the mixture until it is well combined and has the texture of mildly wet sand. (It should clump together when you squeeze it with your fingers.) If it is too dry, moisten it with the water in the spray bottle, one spritz at a time. You do not want the mixture too wet, or it will not set up properly.
- 3. Press the mixture firmly into silicone soap molds or muffin tins lined with paper cups or plastic wrap (for easy removal). Let sit for 1–2 hours.
- 4. After the bath bombs are dry enough that they stick together, remove from the molds or muffin tins (and paper cups), and let bath bombs sit on a fluffy towel overnight before using. If you live in a humid area, you may need to dry the bath bombs for 2 nights before they'll be set enough to use or give away.

EXTRA IDEAS:

- Try using food coloring and dry herbs to decorate the bath bombs a little more.
- Try dividing the batch after mixing the dry ingredients to make bath bombs with different scents or colors. Work with one scent at a time. Mix in the appropriate amount of the wet ingredients, moisten with the spray bottle if necessary, and press firmly into the molds before starting the process over again with another scent.
- Try different essential oils for different purposes. For example, try making some relaxing bath bombs with soothing essential oils (e.g., lavender, ylang ylang, or Roman chamomile) or energizing bath bombs with invigorating essential oils (e.g., citrus oils, peppermint, eucalyptus, or rosemary).

EXFOLIATING FOOT OR BODY SCRUB

Yield: 4 oz. Time: 5 minutes Difficulty: Easy

INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES:

- 1/4 cup Epsom Salt or other exfoliating agent (You could also use coarse sea salt, fine sea salt, raw sugar, brown sugar, table salt, or white sugar. The coarser the salt or sugar is, the more exfoliating it will be.)
- 1/4 cup (60 ml) Sweet Almond Oil
- 2 capsules or 6–8 drops Vitamin E Oil (optional)
- 10-20 drops essential oil
- 4 oz. Glass Salve Jar

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Pour all ingredients into a bowl, and mix together.
- 2. Pour the mixture into a 4 oz. salve jar or small widemouthed jar.
- 3. To use the scrub, place a small amount in your palm, and scrub over moistened skin. Rinse off in a shower or tub.


Notes:

- Be sure to use this scrub only on unbroken skin, and warn your recipients to do the same.
- The oils in this scrub can make the floor of the bathtub or shower slippery, so use extreme caution while rinsing off so you don't fall.

EXTRA IDEAS:

- Use ultramarine powders or other natural powders and oil-soluble colorants to color your scrubs.
- Try using different coarsenesses of salt or sugar to create progressively smoother scrubs (i.e., a coarse "buffing" scrub, followed by a fine "polishing" scrub) with different relaxing essential oils in each scrub.
- Try combining two or more exfoliating agents to get a different feel for your scrub.

ESSENTIAL OIL-SCENTED FINGER PAINTS

Yield: 2 cups (480 ml) Time: 15–20 minutes Difficulty: Easy

INGREDIENTS & SUPPLIES:

- 2 cups (480 ml) cold water
- 1 heaping Tbsp. (~10 g) cornstarch
- Plastic bottles
- Food coloring
- Essential oils

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. In a medium-sized pot, whisk together cold water and cornstarch. Heat over medium heat, stirring often, until mixture thickens.
- 2. Remove from heat, and let cool.
- Pour the mixture into plastic bottles, and add a different color of food coloring to each bottle. Stir with a bamboo skewer (adding more if needed) until you achieve your desired color.
- 4. Add a drop of essential oil to each bottle of paint, and stir in the essential oil with the bamboo skewer. Be sure to choose essential oils that are safe for children.
- 5. Twist the lids onto your bottles, and your paint is ready to enjoy!

NOTE:

It's fun to choose oil scents that go along with each color, and this also makes for a fun sensory experience. For example, mix a drop of lemon oil with the yellow paint, a drop of peppermint oil with the green paint, etc.
