

DEKit Cleaning: Tips and Tricks

DEKit is a closed cell foam product. Once DEKit is installed, it is now like any other surface on the boat. Like anything else; keeping it clean will help maintain that new deck look and feel. When it comes to messes and spills, tending to them as soon as possible makes cleaning that much easier. Hosing off the area or throwing a bucket of water on the mess to dilute it will make cleaning much easier once back at the dock.

GENERAL PURPOSE CLEANING

- Wet the deck
- Apply boat soap in a bucket or spread across the deck.
- Scrub deck with medium bristle brush.
- Allow to sit for 2-4 minutes.
- Rinse deck thoroughly with water

REMOVING FISH BLOOD, SUN SCREEN, OIL AND RUST MARKS

- ALL MESSES Spray Nine[®] Heavy Duty Cleaner+Degreaser +Disinfectant will remove almost anything you throw at DEKit.
- Fish Blood (1-cup bleach per 1-gallon water)
- Rust Marks (Marine grade rust cleaners)
- Sunscreen (General Purpose, Non Acidic Degreaser)
- Oil (General Purpose, Non Acidic Degreaser

Steps to use:

- Wet surface of DEKit
- Apply cleaner to affected area.
- Scrub area with medium bristle brush
- Rinse deck thoroughly with water
- Repeat steps if necessary
