Servicing Guide

Just like your car, regular service extends the life of your Oscar g3 stroller.

Below are some helpful tips to keep your wheels smooth and enjoyable to use. We recommend servicing your stroller at least every 6 months and an inspection at least once a month.

HERE'S HOW TO SERVICE YOUR OSCAR G3 AT HOME:

- **Inspect all the rivets and screws** that connect your stroller together. They should be clean, tight and secure.
- **Remove the wheels** (back and front) and wipe them clean with a damp clean rag to remove any dirt, sand or other debris. Put a small amount of greasy lubricant, such as Vaseline or Lithium Grease (available from your local Bunnings or Mitre 10), on the front and rear wheel pins before reinserting into stroller. This helps to protect from corrosion and keep things moving smoothly.
- **Make sure the fold joints are free of dirt and debris.** Wipe clean with a damp cloth. We suggest cleaning the fold joints when the stroller frame is folded. Apply some WD-40 or Silicone spray (available at Bunnings, Mitre 10 or your local supermarket) to the moving hinges.
- **Make sure the brake calipers are free from dirt, sand and debris.** Engage the brake and wipe the calipers clean with a damp cloth. Apply some WD-40 or Silicone spray to the brake calipers and inside the brake housing (behind the brake pedal). Engage and disengage the brake a number of times to coat the parts in lubricant. To prevent the metal components from rusting, wipe down your stroller frame after beach or rain use, especially when used in windy & exposed areas. Always store in a dry place. Do not store your stroller in a damp environment that is not well insulated (such as an unfinished basement or outdoor shed).
- **If you do find some corrosion forming on the rivets or screws,** you can wipe it clean with a damp cloth and Jif. Dry it overnight, then apply a clear lacquer afterwards, such as Rust-Oleum Clear spray (available from Bunnings) or clear nail polish. This prevents the corrosion from re-forming.

Washing instructions

FRAME WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

Clean with a damp rag and a little mild detergent (such as dishwashing liquid or car wash detergent). Dry thoroughly. **DO NOT** use abrasives (such as “Jif”) because they may scratch your stroller frame.

FABRIC WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

For Stroller shoulder pad, Carry Cot cover, Carry Cot liner, Carry Cot mattress cover, Capsule shoulder pad, Capsule canopy

Machine wash (front loader only) in cold water, gentle cycle with mild detergent. Dry flat and away from direct sunlight. Do not dry clean, iron or bleach.

For Capsule seat cover, Capsule Newborn Insert, Stroller canopy

Spot clean or hand wash in cold water with mild detergent. Dry flat and away from direct sunlight before re-use or storage. Do not dry clean, iron or bleach.
