Unemployment Insurance is a joint state-federal program that provides cash benefits to eligible workers who are unemployed through no fault of their own. Each state administers a separate unemployment insurance program, but all states follow the same guidelines established by federal law. Services include job search, referral and placement assistance, reemployment services to unemployment insurance claimants, labor market information, and individual skills assessments. Childcare and transportation services may be available to enable an individual to participate in these activities.
