- 2. CAREFULLY REMOVE PASSENGER SIDE ENGINE COVER
- 3. CAREFULLY REMOVE WIRING HARNESS FROM FRONT OF HEAD
- 4. USE SUPPLIED BUTTON HEAD HARDWARE TO INSTALL MOUNTING RING TO MOUNTING BRACKET
- 5. USE SHORTER OF THE LARGER HARDWARE TO BOLT THE MOUNTING BRACKET TO THE FRONT OF THE HEAD (LOWER HOLE)
- 6. USE THE LARGER BOLT TO SECURE THE TOP OF THE MOUNTING BRACKET TO THE HEAD
- 7. REINSTALL WIRING HARNESS INTO HOLES ON BRACKET
- 8. USE BUTTON HEAD HARDWARE TO ATTACH CAN TO MOUNTING RING (DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN)
- 9. REMOVE CRANK CASE VENT HOSE
- 10.INSTALL LONGER HOSE FROM REAR PART TO INLET PORT ON CAN
- 11.REMOVE 90 DEGREE BOOT FROM FACTORY PIPE
- 12.INSTALL DOUBLE ENDED BARBED FITTING INTO 90 DEGREE BOOT
- 13. INSTALL BOOT ONTO ORIGINAL MOUNT LOCATION
- 14.INSTALL HOSE FROM 90 DEGREE BOOT TO OUTLET SIDE OF CAN
- 15. FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS ON TOP OF CAN
- 16.REPLACE ENGINE COVER AND YOU'RE ALL DONE!!
