## Dodge Durango/Jeep Grand Cherokee Mid Muffler Delete Instructions

## **Professional installation recommended!**

## Tools needed:

Jack

Jack stands

13mm wrench

15mm wrench

Permanent marker

Tape measure

Preferred cutting tool

- 1. Raise vehicle and place jack stands under a safe location and lower onto stands
- 2. Use tape measure to measure 1" forward of flange on driver side and make mark for cutting location (see Yellow arrow for flange reference)



- 3. Remove the 2 nuts holding the springs against the flange on the driver side and cut on the previously made mark
- 4. Measure 10 inches rear of the muffler and mark with marker and cut on marks (see pink arrow for measuring point)
- 5. Remove clamp forward of the muffler on the passenger side
- 6. Carefully remove 2 13mm bolts holding hangers from the vehicle
- 7. Remove the individual hangers from the muffler and place them onto the new parts
- 8. Slide clamps onto delete parts
- 9. Slip delete parts onto the stock exhaust
- 10. Replace bolts to hold the hangers to the vehicle
- 11. Tighten the clamps
- 12. Lower vehicle and enjoy the new and improved sound
