Biosecurity Pathway

- a. These conditions allow for the import of the following products only: LIST A: Dehydrated human placenta Dehydrated human umbilical cord LIST B: Human breast milk
- b. The products must be imported in volumes no greater than 50 ml for human breast milk and 20 g for dehydrated human placenta and dehydrated human umbilical cord.
- c. The human fluids must be transported in a sealed leak proof container (preferably refrigerated) and placed in a secondary container with absorbent material to absorb any leakage.
- d. The human tissue must be transported in a sealed container.

The consignment must meet specified sourcing and/or processing requirements. To demonstrate compliance with this requirement you must present the following on a Supplier's declaration: For list A products: i) The placenta and umbilical cord have been sterilised

at a minimum temperature of 150°C for 150 minutes, or 160°C for 120 minutes, or 170°C for 60 minutes or 180° for 30 min. For list B products: i) The breast milk has been sterilised at a minimum temperature of 121°C for 15-20 minutes.
