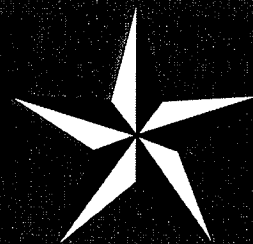

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST READ THIS BEFORE SIGNING AGREEMENT, WAIVER AND RELEASE

In consideration for being permitted by the Durham Recreation and Park District in the activity listed above, I hereby waive, release and discharge any and all which may hereafter occur as a result of my participation in said activity. This release is intended to discourage in advance the above district, its officers, employees and agents from and against any and all liability arising out of or connected in any way with my participation in said activity, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of said district or its officers, employees or agents.

I understand that the above activity may be of a hazardous nature and/or include physical and/or strenuous exercise or activity; that serious accidents occasionally occur during the above sport/activity, and to those participants in the above sport/activity; and occasionally sustain mortal or personal injuries and/or property damages as a consequence thereof. Here's your invitation to showcase your community organization, service organization, or local business, as well as compete for "eternal fame and glory," at the 4th Annual DRPD Community Chili Cook-Off, scheduled for Saturday, November 17, 2018. This event will surely become a well-loved and highly anticipated event in the community and a fun way to raise funds for community organizations such as yours. FYI: Last year's event paid out more than \$950 in prize money to participants.

Enclosed is a team sign-up sheet, as well as cook-off rules. If your team plans to compete this year, (and we hope you will,) please complete the entry form and return it to the District Office at the address below. The cook-off field will be limited to 16 teams, so please, get your entries in A.S.A.P. The cut-off date for entries will be Friday, November 9.

Entry fee for the cook-off is \$50. This money reserves your spot at the cook-off. \$25 of your entry fee will be returned to you on the day of the event as soon as you begin cooking. "No-Shows," will NOT receive a refund.

Chili Cook-Off Format and Rules

Event: Chili Cook-Off
Dates: Saturday, Nov. 17, 2018
Times: Cook-Off Contestants may begin cooking: 7:00a
Tasting available to public: 12:00p
Judging will begin: 1:00p
Location(s): Durham Community Park

- For the purpose of this event, "chili" will be defined as "having" **OR** "not having" beans.
- The event is limited to 16 teams: Each team will consist of no more than two cooks.
- Each team is responsible for supplying all of their needs: EZ-up, table, stove, gas, cooking utensils, as well as ingredients to make at least **THREE GALLONS** of chili.
(Three gallons is the required minimum, but this does not guarantee you won't run out.)
- No electric outlets will be available. No generators will be allowed.
- Ingredients may be "prepped" ahead of time, but all cooking must be done on site, the day of the event.
- Teams may arrive to set up as early as they like, but cooking may begin no earlier than 7:00a
- Canned ingredients will be allowed.
- All teams will be required to include \$50 along with their entry, \$25 of which will be returned the day of the event, once your team shows up and begins cooking. The other \$25 will go towards the total event income prize fund.
- "No shows will NOT receive a refund."
- Booth spaces will be assigned prior to the event, and a map of spaces will be made available to participants, and to the public, the morning of the event.
- Tasting kits will be sold to the public for \$5/ea. Individuals may sample as much chili as they like. All tasting kits will include a ticket used to vote for their favorite chili. Make sure your booth has a container where tickets may be deposited.

- Chili entries will be awarded as follows:
 - Judges choice/Blind taste test: 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place
 - People's choice: 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place
- Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - Judges' choice:
 - 1st place trophy and 25% of total event income
 - 2nd place trophy and 10% of total event income
 - 3rd place trophy and 5% of total event income
 - People's choice:
 - 1st place trophy and 25% of total event income
 - 2nd place trophy and 10% of total event income
 - 3rd place trophy and 5% of total event income

Event Description

Objective 1: Provide an annual family friendly event that brings community members together

Objective 2: Provide opportunity to raise funds for "community service groups/organizations"

Method(s): **Durham Community Chili Cook-Off**

- Invite teams to compete for "bragging rights."
 - Charge teams an entry fee of \$50/team
 - \$25 of which will be returned when teams show up
- Invite the public to chili tasting
 - Sell "tasting-kits" to individuals \$5/person
- Voting/Award
 - Judges Blind Taste Test (Trophy)
 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd
 - People's Choice (Trophy)
 - Public votes by submitting ticket included in "tasting-kit."
 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- Winners will receive cash prize donation to their service group/organization.
 - Judges Choice 1st place 25%, 2nd place 15%, 3rd place 5%
 - Peoples' Choice 1st place 25%, 2nd place 15%, 3rd place 5%
