Safety Instructions

Please read, follow, and keep these instructions.

- Keep earbuds and case away from extreme heat or humidity. Extreme temperatures can cause the device to deform, reduce the battery capacity, and shorten the lifespan of the device.
- Do not use the earbuds at a high volume for extended periods of time. To avoid hearing damage, use your earbuds at a comfortable and moderate volume level.
- Stop using this product immediately if it causes pain or discomfort.
- Do not submerge the earbuds or case in water.
- Keep earbuds, case, and accessories out of reach of children and pets to avoid accidents.
- Do not disassemble or modify the earbuds or case for any reason. This may cause a malfunction or product failure. Please contact us at info@bb-tek.com for repairs.

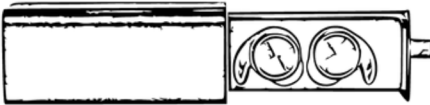

How to Use

Connect your device

1. Remove earbuds from the charging case by pulling the rubber tab on the outside of the case.
2. Press and hold both L/R earbuds for 10 seconds. If the earbuds are charged, you will see a blinking blue and red light on the earbuds, indicating they are ready to be paired.
3. Open the Bluetooth settings on the device you would like to connect your earbuds to.
4. Find *BBTEK TWS* and select to connect.

If there is an issue connecting both earbuds to your phone or you cannot search for the Bluetooth name:

1. Place both earbuds back into the charging case.
2. Delete the earbuds from the Bluetooth pairings on your device.
3. Turn your device's Bluetooth settings off.
4. Turn your device's Bluetooth settings back on.
5. Reconnect your device to the earbuds following the connection instructions above.

How to Use

Charge your device

1. Place both earbuds inside the charging case.
2. Close the charging case and connect the case to the included USB cable.
3. Connect the USB cable to power. The earbuds and charging case will charge simultaneously.

For proper use, do not insert earbuds into the charging case if they are wet, damaged, or dirty.

While charging, the case and/or charger may become hot. This does not affect the device's lifespan or performance and is in the device's normal range of operation.

Do not disassemble, modify, or attempt to repair your device. Placing objects, such as magnetic stripe cards, including credit cards, phone cards, passbooks, and boarding passes, next to the device may cause damage to the device's magnetic field.

Touch Controls

Function	What To Do	Voice Prompt	Light Activity
Power on	Press and hold L or R earbud for 1.5 seconds, or take the earbuds out of the case to turn on automatically.	Power on	Flashing red and blue lights
Power off	Press and hold L or R earbud for 10 seconds, or place earbuds in the case and close to turn off automatically.	Power off	Flashing red light for 1 second
Bluetooth pairing	While earbuds are off, press and hold both L/R earbuds for 10 seconds.	Pairing mode	Alternating red and blue lights
Incoming call	Answer or reject the call	Caller announced	Flashing blue lights
Answer call	Tap L or R earbud twice		LED off
Reject call	Press and hold L or R earbud	Call rejected	LED off
End call	Tap L or R earbud twice		LED off

Function	What To Do	Voice Prompt	Light Activity
Play / pause	Tap L or R earbud twice		LED off
Next song	Press button on the R earbud 3 times		LED off
Previous song	Press button on the L earbud 3 times		LED off
Volume up	Press button on the R earbud		LED off
Volume down	Press button on the L earbud		LED off
Virtual assistant on	Quickly tap L or R earbud 4 times		
Virtual assistant off	Quickly tap L or R earbud 4 times
