

Monumental Wine Jars

from Spain

These stunning antique jars are collected around the world as artifacts of ancient winemaking.

And, the ancient methods are making a resurgence! Massive *amphorae* and *tinajas* are now being used to store and make additive-free wines. The porous clay naturally protects the wine from oxidation, removing the need for sulfur.



When we discovered that a very old Spanish winery was selling their *tinajas*, we immediately purchased the first two available jars.

The large antique jars can be placed in gardens, interiors, and as pool landscape enhancements, on their sides, and in custom stands displayed vertically.



Monumental *tinajas* grace the United Nations building in Geneva, city parks, and private gardens.

Each of these jars is marked, and its custom stand is included.
