CANADIAN & AMERICAN RYE

Rye whisk(e)y tells the story of North American distilling tradition.

American rye whiskey must contain at least 51% rye grain in its mashbill by law, creating its characteristic bold, spicy, and peppery flavours. Once the dominant American whiskey style, it nearly vanished during Prohibition but is experiencing a revival in recent decades.

Canadian rye, meanwhile, is often called "rye" regardless of actual rye content – a historical convention rather than a legal requirement. Nevertheless, craft distillers are reviving traditional high-rye or 100% rye mashbills, with the spirits trending towards smoother, lighter expressions.

Together, these showcase rye's remarkable range: with American ryes generally showing more pronounced spice notes and Canadian expressions possessing easier-going, grain-forward profiles.

Redwood Empire Emerald Giant American Rye Whiskey

Named after the fastest growing Redwood in the world, Emerald Giant's mash-bill is 92% rye, 5% malted barley, and 3% wheat.

Cask:

New charred oak

Nose:

Natural rye followed by a mix of brown sugar, cinnamon and a faint hint of pepper

Palate:

Complex and spicy with a hint of honey and orange peel

Finish:

Peppery with lingering cinnamon

Baldur's Release No. 002

100% Straight Rye Canadian Whisky

Baldur's is made by Last Mountain, a family-owned and operated distillery in Lumsden, SK. It is Saskatchewan's first micro-distillery.

Cask:

Charred oak

Nose:

Spicy cinnamon, cracked black pepper, and a touch of dried fruits

Palate:

A peppery kick with warm baking spices, dark toffee, and a hint of toasted oak

Finish:

Long and warming, with lingering notes of clove, caramel, and a trace of dark chocolate

Wildlife Rye Canadian Craft Whisky

Wild Life Rye Whisky is made from 100% locally grown rye (88%) and barley (12%). It was milled, mashed, fermented, distilled and aged at the Wild Life Distillery in Canmore, Alberta, and is the first rye whisky ever to be made in the town.

Cask:

White American oak

Nose:

Nutmeg, caramel, figs, and banana bread

Palate:

Rye spice, toasted American oak, nutmeg, figs, and green grass

Finish:

Medium-long with rye spice, leather, and soft tannins

Roper's Hold 8 Year Old

Blended Straight Rye Whiskey

Sourced from the United States, but finished and bottled in Canada, Roper's Hold epitomises distilling traditions and cross-border collaborations that transcend national boundaries.

Cask.

Finished in Okanagan Valley Wine Casks

Nose:

Classic rye spices, black pepper, clove, and cinnamon, layered with red fruit

Palate:

Peppery with dried fruit sweetness: raisins, figs, and subtle berry notes

Finish:

Medium to long, spice fades into fruit-forward sweetness with dry, wine-like tannins

Pendleton Directors' Reserve 20 Year Old Canadian Rye Whisky

Each edition of Directors' Reserve is adorned with an authentically leathersmithed neck cuff by third-generation saddle maker Randy Severe, whose family has made custom saddles for nearly 70 years.

Cask:

American oak

Nose:

Toasted coconut, freshly grated cinnamon, oak, vanilla, and orange zest

Palate:

Toasted oak, ripe apples, pears, and bananas sprinkled with warm baking spices

Finish:

Long, mature and smooth

Booker's Little Book VIII A Path Not Taken American Rye Whiskey

"Little Book" was the nickname given to Freddie Noe by his granddad, Booker. A Path Not Taken is a blend of six Kentucky Straight Ryes (4 - 11 years old) and high-rye 18 year old Kentucky Straight Bourbon.

Cask:

Six different oak casks

Nose:

Butterscotch, fresh dill and toasted rye bread

Palate:

Floral notes with sweet apricot, warm baking spices, vanilla, charred oak and a subtle whisper of dark chocolate

Finish:

Long and velvety with an oaky, gentle sweetness
