

<u>FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ECS0080BK ENGINE CASE SLIDER</u> <u>DUCATI HYPERMOTARD 821 2013 (LEFT HAND SIDE ONLY)</u>



Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt - the rubber washers should be thrown away!

Left-hand side (as you sit on bike)

- Remove the two countersunk bolts that secure the inspection cover on the engine case in place, as shown
 above.
- If not already fitted, place the plastic slider onto the metal block, locating the bosses within the holes.
- Remove the o-ring from the OEM inspection cover, and locate into the circular groove on the new metal block
- Insert new button head bolts with washers on through the slider.
- Offer up to bike.
- Tighten evenly to manufactures specified torque.
- Fit bubble sticker as shown above.

LA FAÇON DONT LE KIT EST EMBALLE NE CORRESPOND PAS FORCEMENT A LA FAÇON DE MONTER LES PIECES SUR LA MOTO.

Notez que si les kits sont emballés avec des rondelles en caoutchouc servant à tenir les composants, ces rondelles doivent être jetées.

Coté gauche assis sur la moto:

- Enlever les 2 boulons qui fixent la protection carter moteur en place, photo ci dessus.
- Si cela n'est pas déjà fait, placez le slider en plastique sur le bloc de métal.
- Enlever le joint torique de la protection d'origine, et logez le dans la rainure circulaire sur le nouveau bloc de métal.
- Insérer les nouveaux boulons avec les rondelles à travers les sliders.
- Monter l'ensemble sur la moto.
- Serrer de façon égale aux couples spécifiques d'usine.
- Mettre les stickers en gomme R&G.
