




Put the motorcycle on a work stand, so that the rear shock can be safely removed.




Open the seat and remove the rear panel by loosening the two screws.




Remove the center panel (lower) by loosening the screw and the two bolts.



Remove the cover on both side by loosening the five bolts.

Remove the passenger footrest.


Assembly the reservoir clamp on to the bracket.


Reassembly the passenger footrest together with the reservoir bracket.

Install Öhlins shock absorber with the reservoir andhose as in the picture.

Tighten the bolts according to the vehicles work shop manual.

Reverse all procedures to reassembly the vehicle.





Note!

Lower the vehicle so that the suspension is slightly compressed before tightening the screws.


७ Caution!
