

Adjustments

Compression and Rebound Adjuster

Use a 3mm Allen kev

to adjust.

Shock Absorber for Yamaha R1



How to install How to install

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

When installing, read the Vehicle Service Manual.

1

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

⚠ Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

2

Remove the lower and upper attachments of the original shock absorber.

3

Remove the shock absorber upwards.

• Note!

Recommendation! Before installing the Öhlins shock absorber:

- Clean the vehicle thoroughly
- Adjust the length of the shock absorber (check the headlight angle after adjusting the length!)

Δ

Install the Öhlins shock absorber in the same way as the original unit. Use the original screws.

• Note!

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

▲ Warning!

1

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
