

# Fitting Instructions for SRG0024 Radiator Guard HONDA CROSSTOURER '12-



In This Kit There Should Be
1x Radiator Guard (SS RAD0024)
2x 100mm Lengths of self-adhesive Foam
1x 4mm Cable Tie x 220mm long



- To fit the radiator guard to the bike cut the foam strip provided into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the radiator guard frame, so that they sit between the radiator guard and the radiator.
- Remove the two bolts that secure the plastic radiator surround in place on either side of the bike, as shown in picture 1.
- Unclip the sides of the plastic radiator surround on either side of the bike, as shown in picture 2.
- Remove the two push rivets that secure the bottom of the plastic radiator surround, arrowed in picture 3.
- The plastic radiator surround can now be removed from the front of the radiator.
- Remove the 10mm bolt that secures the top of the radiator in place, arrowed in picture 4.
- Now offer the radiator guard into place. Take care to ensure the radiator slides up and under the brake lines and horn wiring, as shown in picture 5.
- Locate the bolt through the radiator guard and into the top radiator mount but do not tighten at this stage.
- Locate the cable tie through the remaining mount on the radiator guard, around the plastic mount and tighten, as shown in picture 7.
- Offer the front of the plastic radiator surround back in place sandwiching the radiator guard between the radiator and plastic surround, and return the push rivets in place.
- Now tighten the bolt to secure the radiator in place.
- Clip the plastic radiator surrounds side pieces back in place and refit the original bolts.

# INSTRUCTIONS DE MONTAGE POUR SRG0024 Grille de protection radiateur HONDA CROSSTOURER '12-



In This Kit There Should Be

1x Grille de protection (SS RAD0024)

2x 100mm Mousse autocollante.

1x 4mm Collier de serrage x 220mm long



- Couper la mousse autocollante en bandeaux de 10mm de large et collez-les au bas du cadre de support protection radiateur, de façon à ce qu'ils se retrouvent entre la grille de protection et le radiateur.
- Enlever les 2 boulons qui fixent le contour de radiateur en plastic en placer de chaque coté de la moto (photo 1).
- Déclipser les cotés du contour radiateur en plastic de chaque coté de la moto (photo 2).
- Enlever les 2 rivets qui fixent le bas du contour de radiateur en plastic (photo 3).
- Le contour radiateur en plastic peut maintenant être enlevé par l'avant du radiateur.
- Enlever le boulon 10mm qui fixe le haut du radiateur en place (photo 4).
- Mettre la grille de protection en place. Veiller à ce que le radiateur glisse et sous les lignes de frein et la corne de câblage (Photo 5).
- Placer le boulon à travers la grille de protection radiateur et dans le support radiateur supérieur mais ne rien bloquer pour le moment.
- Placer le collier de serrage à travers le support restant sur la grille de protection, autour du support plastic puis serrer (photo 7).
- Remettre l'avant du contour radiateur plastic en place, prenant en sandwich la grille de protection radiateur entre le radiateur et le contour plastic, puis remettre les rivets en place.
- Serrer le boulon pour fixer le radiateur en place.
- Reclipser les pièces latérales du contour radiateur plastic en place puis remettre les boulons d'origine.
