All items must be **clearly and indelibly** named, preferably with sewn in labels.

Hair should be neat, presentable and of a natural colour. Long hair should be tied up or back with a white, gold, black or grey band or fastening.

Pupils are allowed to have their ears pierced and are allowed to wear one small pair of stud earrings only. These must be able to be taken out (by the pupil) for all PE/games and swimming activities. They will be kept in a safe place by the student and members of staff will not be responsible for any items of jewellery. Therefore it is advisable that piercings only take place at the start of the summer holidays and only with pupils old enough to manage the above tasks. Parents can appeal this ruling on religious or cultural grounds but health and safety must be the first priority for the school. Multiple piercings are not allowed.

A wristwatch is permitted. NO other jewellery to be worn.

ALL PUPILS ARE EXPECTED TO ADHERE TO THE UNIFORM LIST.
ALL UNIFORM SHOULD BE PURCHASED VIA SCHOOL OR DIRECT WITH UNIFORMITY.
