Overview


The PIVOT LTRM Mount consists of several parts:

- Contoured attachment plate
- High-deflection AMPS adapter with PPK-1 mounting plate

Total installation time for a shipset (CA and FO) is approximately five (5) minutes. Captain and First Officer devices are mirrored and have the same installation and removal process. Installation does not require tools. Accomplishing the steps detailed in the manual provide any user with required data for successful installation or removal. Installation Instructions

Hold the device with one hand and move it into position over the window shroud.



With one hand, lift the forward chart spring clip. Slide the device underneath the clip. Lower the chart spring clip and ensure it captures the 2 vertical tabs on the forward edge of the device.



Raise the outboard chart spring clip. Rotate the device so the outboard edge of the device is flush against the raised clip housing. Lower the clip to capture the 2 vertical tabs on the outboard edge of the device.

Removal Instructions


Lift up the outboard chart spring clip. Rotate the device inward so the vertical tabs are moved away from the chart spring clip. Lower the chart spring clip.



Lift the forward chart spring clip up. Slide the device out from underneath the raised chart spring clip. Lower the clip once the device is clear.



The removal is complete.

Scratches and other surface imperfections are typical and do not affect the performance of the device.


