Convoy C8 UV Flashlight Manual

Where to Start

When you 1st open the box the 1st thing you will need to do is to charge your 18650 batteries.

The flat end of each battery is the negative end and the tipped end is the positive side. Put the batteries in your charger by matching up the positive and negative ends to the labels on the charger.

When batteries require charging the led light on the charger will turn either RED or Yellow. Leave the batteries in the charger until the led turns GREEN.

Loading the batteries in your Convoy C8

Start by unscrewing the end cap off of the flashlight. Insert two 18650 batteries with both batteries tip 1st. So the tips are pointed towards the lens end of the light. Then screw the end cap back on. Having one or both batteries facing the wrong way will result in the light not working. Also make sure all 3 sections of the light are twisted tight and snug. If any of the sections are loose the light will not work properly. The power button is on the end of the butt cap. To turn on click the button once. To turn off click the button again.



Runtimes will depend on the quality of the batteries. Do not mix uncharged and charged batteries together. Only use 2 freshly charged batteries.

Proper use of the Convoy C8

The Convoy C8 flashlight is a very high powered 365nm filtered UV flashlight. Do not point towards your eyes or others. Always use eye protection. UV blocking glasses are recommended and also available at <u>www.yooperlites.com</u>

When on the beach or in the field hold the light in a way that it is close to eye level, then point the lens end toward the rocks on the beach 10 to 20 feet in front of you. Using a sweeping motion scan the entire beach where rocks are present.

Helpful tips and tricks for a successful Yooperlite Hunt

- 1. Wait for dark, starting too early will only waste batteries.
- 2. Never go alone, always tell someone exactly where you plan to hunt.
- 3. Always use glow sticks or some form of marker to mark your way back off the beach.
- 4. Respect private property and Google rules and laws about collecting in your area.
- 5. Bring a bag or backpack for finds.
- 6. Be on the lookout for other Fluorescent minerals, many fossils and other minerals fluoresce in the Great Lakes Region.
- 7. Yooperlites can be found throughout the Great Lakes Region but are most prevalent along the shores of Lake Superior and Lake Michigan.
