1. HOW TO UNFOLD YOUR ZIP SERIES MODEL



Step 1: Ensure both rear wheels are attached. Refer to user manual for further details.



Step 2: Release fold lever.



Step 3: Move the top bag support away from front wheel assembly until vou hear it click.



Step 4: The handle is now free to pull upwards. The handle will naturally unfold as you continue to pull until the handle is completely open.



Step 5: Ensure that the latch at the bottom of the handle clicks into place.



Step 6: Close the fold lever to lock the handle into place in one of three positions.

Step 7: Push the top bag support down to move it into position.

2. FIFTH/FOURTH FOLDABLE REAR WHEEL

The MGI Zip Series models come with a fourth/fifth foldable and extendable rear wheel. This wheel MUST be unfolded and extended into position at all times when the Zip Series is in use. This will provide the ultimate stability across all terrains. This fifth/fourth wheel should be cleaned regularly with a cloth to ensure it can be folded and retracted as required for storage.



3. BATTERY CONNECTING BATTERY


Position the battery on your Zip Series and push the battery down to secure it. Push the handle down to connect the battery. Your Zip Series has been equipped with a fail safe battery connection, so it will not move when you connect the battery. Your Zip Series will only start via the top handle button or the remote.

BATTERY CHARGING

Before using your MGI Zip Series for the first time you must fully charge the battery overnight.

Plug the charger AC lead into a power point - the green LED illuminates to indicate the charger is on.





Plug the charger output connection into the connector on the front of the battery - the red LED illuminates to indicate it is charging.

When the charging LED indicator has turned green, the battery is fully charged and ready for use.

Please refer to the battery charger user manual for further information.

LITHIUM BATTERY CARE

Your lithium battery casing and connections should be regularly inspected for damage and wear. If your connections are in need of repair or replacement, please contact your local MGI service centre for assistance immediately. Under no circumstances should a Lithium Battery that has been dropped, damaged or immersed, partially or fully in water, be connected to a Zip Series or charger. By doing so, the battery will become a fire hazard and may cause the Lithium cells to combust. Please contact the MGI Service Centre to arrange a replacement.



WATER DAMAGE - STRONG WARNING

If your Zip Series battery becomes immersed in water even for a short time, discontinue its use and purchase a replacement.

Water-damaged lithium batteries pose a significant fire risk and should be disposed of, responsibly, as soon as possible.

MGI buggies are designed to be used in all conditions, however, a level of caution is required when operating your Zip Series in wet conditions:

MGI recommend carrying a hand towel to wipe away any excessive water from the top box during use. Keep your Zip Series on the fairway and paths when possible and avoid boggy/muddy terrain and puddles. MGI buggies are designed to be resistant to wet conditions, however, they are not waterproof. Under no circumstances should you clean your Zip Series using a pressure washer or hose.

MGI recommends cleaning away excess dirt/debris with a brush and wiping down with a damp cloth.

Incursion of water or moisture into the battery and/buggy will void all stipulated warranties on the effected parts.

4. NAVIGATOR AT AND NAVIGATOR OWNERS ONLY - CHARGING YOUR REMOTE CONTROL

PLEASE NOTE: Your remote control is located in a bracket on the back of the frame just below the T Bar Handle. Use two fingers to dislodge remote control from bracket.

Before you start using your Zip Navigator you must fully charge the remote control internal lithium ion battery for approximately 6 hours or overnight using the USB cord provided.

To charge the remote, plug in the USB cord into the USB port on the base of the remote. The cable can be plugged into your PC or Laptop for charging; alternatively, plug the cable into an AC adapter (not included).





Whilst charging, the LED will flash. Once fully charged, the LED will remain solid.



5. REAR WHEEL POSITIONS

Your Zip Series is designed to allow the rear wheels to be in two positions. The position is determined by where the wheel is locked on the axle in either of the two grooves (see picture at the top of the next page). The drive position is used during the normal operation of the Zip Series. The free wheel position is used to push it freely, if required.

i. Drive position - Lock the wheel into the inner groove. To do so, press the black release toggle on the wheel hub, push the wheel onto the axle as far as possible and gently pull back until you hear a click. To test for drive position try rolling the wheel backwards. If you feel resistance then the wheel is now in drive position and ready to use. Repeat for both wheels.

ii. Free wheel - Lock the wheel into the outer groove. To do this, press the black release button on the wheel hub, push the wheel on to the axle and push the release button onto the groove. To test for free wheel position try rolling the wheel backwards. The wheel should spin freely with no resistance. Repeat for both wheels.



6. LUBRICATE AXLES

To avoid wear on the Zip Series axles, apply some petroleum jelly to the exposed shaft. This will need to be cleaned and re-applied monthly. Please refer to the user manual for further information.

7.SERVICE AND REPAIR CENTRES

For all servicing, please do not go back to your place of purchase.

To find your nearest service centre visit mgigolf.com

For warranty repairs to be authorised you MUST provide proof of purchase. Please keep this with you as well as your serial number you can record in this manual. It is most important you register your MGI Zip Series online for warranty purposes.



8.PURCHASING PARTS AND ACCESSORIES

You are welcome to service your Zip Series out of warranty, by purchasing parts direct from MGI. Please call or email to discuss the right parts and instructions.

9. LOAD-BEARING LIMITATION

The Zip Series are designed to transport one golf bag, 14 clubs, accessories and other paraphernalia. It is not to be used as an aid to help users traverse up/down hills or slopes. Doing so will cause damage to the drive system of the Zip Series and, as such, will void all stipulated warranties on parts affected.
