Hidea Winterizing Checklist - 6hp

Required - Winterizing

Fill the fuel tank(s) and add fuel stabilizer.
Run the motor for a few minutes to flush the water system with fresh clean water.
Remove the rubber plug from the air box.
While the motor is running, turn off or disconnect the fuel supply.
Let the motor run for 1-2 minutes, then spray fogging oil into the air box towards the intake port of the carburetor. Continue to spray fogging oil into the intake until the motor stops running.
Place the rubber plug back on the air box.
Drain any leftover fuel out of the carburetor by removing the plug screw on the bottom of the carburetor bowl. Be sure to put the plug screw back in.
Store the motor upright for the winter.
Recommended - Maintenance
Change the engine oil. Use 10w30 engine oil.
Change the lower unit gear oil. Use 80W90 gear oil.
Replace the anode.
Replace the impeller and inspect the water pump housing and plate.
Replace the fuel filter.
