

Suggested Materials for Art of Limited Palette Online Workshop

Hazel is using Schmincke brand watercolour paint.

Colours for Part 1--Colour Theory and Exercise
(a warm and cool version of each of the primary colours)

- Indian Yellow
- Aureolin
- Cadmium red,
- Ruby Red (Permanent Rose)
- Ultramarine Blue,
- Prussian Blue

Colours needed for Part 2--Let's make a painting!

- Indian Yellow
- Ruby Red (Permanent Rose)
- Prussian Blue

Paper:

For the painting: Hazel is using 100% cotton rough surface (brand: Khadi)
For the Colour Circle exercise: practice watercolour paper, Hazel is using the back of an old painting on Saunders Waterford paper.

Brushes:

Hazel is using sable brushes, sizes: 10, 8, 6, a 3/4inch flat brush and a rigger.

- Water
- Kitchen Towel
- 2B Pencil
- Kneadable/Putty eraser
- Masking Tape to keep paper flat while wet and to use as a circle guide.
