1 - TURN THE UNIT ON / OFF:

Press the button on the top of the unit to turn on the thermometer.

To turn the unit off manually, press and hold the button on top of the unit for button for 3 seconds. If not turned off manually, the thermometer will turn off automatically after 20 minutes without use.

2 - TO SWITCH BETWEEN CELSIUS OR FAHRENHEIT DEGREES:

Press the "F/C" button on the back of the unit to switch between the degrees Celsius (°C) and degrees Fahrenheit (°F) temperature display formats.

3 - BACKLIGHT FEATURE:

Press the button on top of the unit once to illuminate the backlight. The light stays on for 10 seconds.

4 - TO INSTALL / CHANGE BATTERIES:

Warning: batteries may pose a choking hazard. Do not let children handle batteries.

This item uses one CR2032 battery. Batteries should be removed from the thermometer if consumed or if the product is to be left unused for a duration of time.

It is recommended to clean all battery contacts prior to installation.

Always purchase the correct size and grade of battery most suitable for the intended use. Ensure all batteries are installed correctly with regard to polarity (+ and -). Remove used batteries promptly.

- 1. Battery door is located on the back of the unit.
- Using a coin, carefully remove the cover. Using a firm but even downward pressure, rotate the battery cover to the open () position.

- Place one CR2032 battery positive side up making sure that the clip snaps over the battery to hold it in place.
- 5. Replace the battery cover rotating it to the closed () position.
