

Seal the Seams for Heavy or Extended Rain:

MSR chooses not to seam tape our lightweight tents because seam tape can flake off prematurely, leaving you without waterproof defense. Our precision stitching and water-resistant thread create a far more durable seam. If you are a foul-weather camper, we recommend sealing the seams with GEAR AID® Seam Grip +FC™ Fast Cure Sealant or Seam Grip +WP™ for maximum waterproof defense, post purchase and pre-first use.

Never Store Your Tent Wet:

Storing your tent while it's wet (or even just damp) leads to premature breakdown of the fabric and coatings.

Treat Your Poles Well During Setup:

Most pole damage occurs during setup. Don't allow the shock cord to pull and snap the ends together as this can damage the pole ends.

Use a Footprint:

Footprints keep your tent floor clean and dry and they minimize floor wear by protecting it from excessive abrasion.

Don't Rush the Zippers:

Be kind to your zippers. Go slow when zipping.
