## **Ballpoint Pens**

- "Parker" style ballpoint
- The most commonly used ballpoint ink cartridge in the world.
- Also referred to as a "G2 ballpoint" size, not to be confused with the "Pilot G2" which is a different size.
- Manufactured in different viscosities from thick ink (like a "Bic" pen) to very smooth, thin ink (Schmidt EasyFLOW 9000)
- Available in multiple colors (black, blue, red, green, purple, magenta, turquoise)
- Widths: Broad, Medium, Fine, Extra Fine Needle Point
- We recommend the following brands:
  - o Schmidt EasyFLOW 9000, Schmidt P900
  - o Monteverde regular ballpoint and gel
  - o Parker Quink (Gel)
- "Cross" style ballpoint
- Available in multiple colors (black, blue, red)
- Widths: Broad, Medium, Fine

## **Rollerball Pens**

- "International Standard" Rollerball
