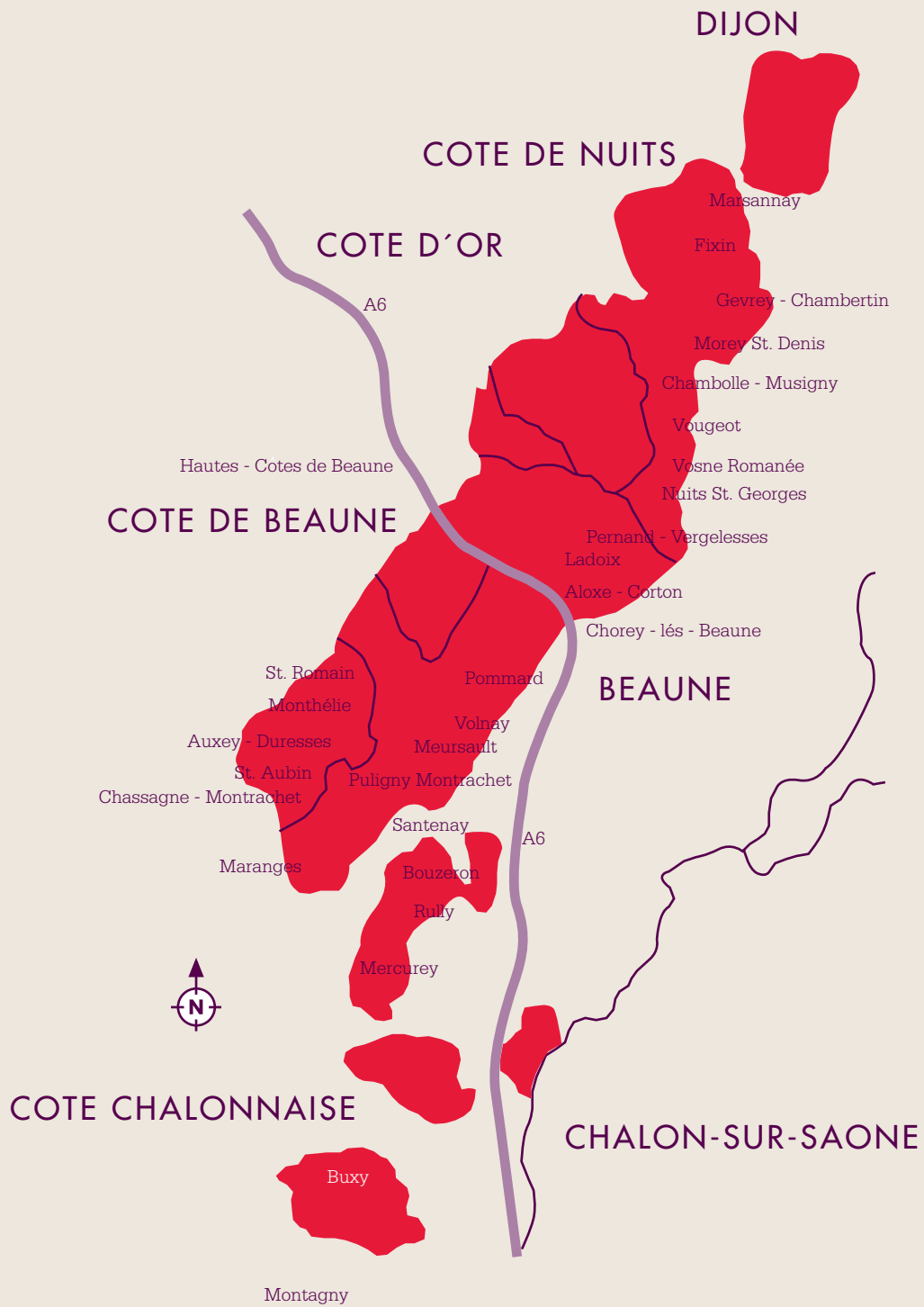




BURGUNDY
EN PRIMEUR
2013



2014 has been an exciting year for Goedhuis & Co, receiving two major awards for our Burgundy list, from both the International Wine Challenge and Decanter Wine Magazine as UK Burgundy Specialists of the Year. We are absolutely delighted with this reward for 30 years work in the region but the credit must really go to our growers from some of the finest estates in the Côte d'Or.

This En Primeur list is our flagship offer. We would also like to highlight a number of other estates, with whom we work extremely closely. The list includes such dignitaries as Marquis d'Angerville, Sebastien Cathiard, Jean-Marie Fourrier, Anne-Claude Leflaive, Dominique Lafon, Laurent Ponsot and Armand Rousseau; some release their wines later in the year, all are in very short supply and consequently are strictly allocated.

2013 Burgundy: "Bright and Brilliant"

Two words repeatedly came up in my tasting notes for the very fine 2013 vintage: brightness and brilliance. Whether red or white, all the wines have wonderfully vivid colours; opaque purple or raspberry for the reds, crystalline lime and lemon for the whites, and they have an incredible sheen to them. Similarly the fruit flavours were amazingly bright, some with a real zestiness, all with an incredible sense of purity and fabulous definition.

2013 was by no means a relaxing year for the Burgundian vigneron. The seasons tested their nerve to the hilt, but the result, twelve months on, tasting the wines in cask has been reward indeed for all their effort and hard work.

Sadly it has been another small harvest. Whilst a positive for the ultimate quality of the wines, this third small harvest in a row (on average 30% down) puts extreme financial pressure on the estates. Unfortunately for us Burgundy lovers, it means there is so little wine to share around.

The Growing Season

So what were the key influences on the style of this vintage? At almost every phase of the vines' development the weather conditions caused many a sleepless night for even the most laid back of vignerons...

The winter was hardy, always a positive, clearing the soils of unwanted diseases and bugs, however the cold weather went on for longer than usual delaying both budding, and, more importantly, the flowering. When flowering did eventually start later in June than normal (as late as 25th June in some vineyards) temperatures remained surprisingly cool. This restricted the fruit set which had a huge impact on yields and volumes at harvest time, however, in many instances, this was the driving force behind the eventual excellent quality of this fine vintage.

July and early August remained quite cool, however the real disaster was a 40 minute flash hail storm on the 24th July which reputedly devastated 1,300 hectares of vines in the Côte de Beaune. The worst affected were the vineyards of Savigny Lès Beaune and sectors of Meursault and Pommard, where certain vineyards lost 90% of their crop. At Chandon de Briailles a normal crop is 200 casks, in 2013 they made just 50. At their Savigny Les Lavières vineyard a normal production of 20 casks was down to a miserly 3. Jean-Pierre Charlot at Domaine Voillot reported similar losses in certain of his vineyards.

Fortunately though the following days and throughout the months of August and September remained clear, dry and not too hot. This avoided the risk of rot and serious fruit damage and as a result Yves Confuron at Domaine de Courcel commented "that he had never seen such good maturity on hail affected vines". Further north, in the Côte de Nuits, growers watched with sympathy, but also huge relief that their vines had escaped similar destruction.

September was much kinder; in particular Jean-Marie Fourrier quoted the fabulous light aiding photosynthesis and excellent fruit maturity and ripeness. As a result he even thinks he possibly prefers his 2013s over his already brilliant 2012s...



The result of all this is that the 2013 vintage was the latest harvest date in the last 30 years with many growers picking their first bunches in early October and some domaines not until the 15th. Conditions were good and whilst quantities were limited, the fruit that came in was in excellent condition, clean with slightly lower sugars than some years and very good acid levels. The vigneron's work was certainly not over and for many just beginning.

In the Cellar

Even for the older hands this was a stimulating vintage to make as so many decisions in the chai influenced the style of the final wines. Louis Boillot and Ghislaine Barthod said that 2013 was a year for gentle handling of the fruit during the fermentation. This allowed the true expression of the terroir to shine as it really is a terroir driven vintage. Jacques Devauges at Domaine de l'Arlot likens many of the characteristics of the vintage to 2008, but with more clarity and polish. He commented on the acid balance and therefore used a few more whole bunches than he did in 2012. This provided an additional level of complexity and sweetness, and reduced the acidity in his wines. Some estates used slightly less new oak than normal to let the purity of the delicious fruit content really express itself to a maximum.

The Wines

The wines, both red and white are lovely; they are a Burgundy lover's dream and what growers describe as "a vintage of the soil or terroir". Later picked vintages always produce wines with a great level of authenticity, reflecting their origins and purity. This is certainly the case in 2013.

The red wines are very precise. They have a lovely clarity of fruit and my often quoted brightness. There is a strong sense of balance between fruit, alcohol, tannins and acidity. My inclination is that they will have two phases of drinking; with their lovely purity of fruit, they will drink extremely well young, but I suspect that, with their excellent freshness, they have the propensity to make old bones. For anybody who really likes the flavours of very old Pinot Noir this is a vintage to keep for the long term. They could make fabulous 30 or 40 year old wines, possibly even matching the amazing 1947 Volnay 1er Cru Champans I had with Jean Pierre Charlot during my travels!

The whites were described by many growers as part 2011 and part 2012; they have excellent focus, direction and fine levels of concentration. Few people keep their white wines for the long term; I think they will benefit from a year or two in bottle and then will give stunning drinking, beautifully reflecting the individual appellation from which they come.

To conclude this small crop of very true wines are everything that true followers of red and white Burgundy look for in their wines.

● **Chablis 1er Cru Côte de Léchet**

The exposed south easterly vineyard of Léchet facing the Grand Cru sites has produced a wine balancing ripeness with tension and drive. A very classical Chablis style, with fine depth on the mid palate and a lively bite of citrus fruit on the finish. Drink 2016 – 2020

● **Chablis 1er Cru Beauroy**

£155.00 per 12 Bottles In Bond

The warm early ripening location of Beauroy undoubtedly helped its vines in 2013. A lovely cuvée with appealing citrus fruit aromas. There are hints of acacia honey and melons and a rounded ripeness in the palate provides for a wine with charm and balance. Drink 2015 – 2019

DOMAINE JEAN-PAUL & BENOIT DROIN Chablis

There cannot be many French wine producing estates who can trace their links back to Francois 1er's reign in 1547. Benoit Droin can, and is the 14th generation since his ancestor Jean Droin first became involved with a parcel of vines in Les Clos. This wealth of experience and the luxury of owning 25 hectares of some of the finest

parcels within the area has allowed Benoit to take the estate to the very pinnacle of the appellation. Depending on the weight and style of the Cru, Benoit has increasingly moved away from an excessive use of oak in the maturation and today, his wines are as fine an example of mineral drive as one can get.

Based in Gevrey-Chambertin, this is a substantial Domaine in Burgundian terms with 32 ha of vines. The Geantet style is to make quite lavish wines. Vincent and Fabien prefer to bottle

their wines quite early to allow the fruit to really express itself. For a fruit driven vintage such as 2013 their wines have a real appeal and will provide youthful and mid term pleasure.

Arnaud Mortet and his mother Laurence run this stunning 11 hectare Domaine meticulously. Started from humble beginnings by Arnaud's grandfather Charles in 1956 with just a single hectare of vines selling all his fruit to the local negociants. Today the wines of Denis Mortet are considered the very epitome of Gevrey Chambertin, its Grand Crus and neighbouring appellations. Arnaud's

youthful looks are misleading to his experience; having a preference for spending his formative years in the fields with his parents rather than at school, he appreciates that the route to success for great wines is very much in the vineyard. This is a domaine which makes hugely stylish wines, with a real sense of integrity and terroir.

● **Bourgogne Rouge Cuvée de Noble Souche**

Arnaud Mortet ages this wine in 20% new oak casks, which provides for a lovely sweetness and subtle chocolate and vanilla characteristics supporting the crisp red fruit flavours. A good pure Pinot style. Drink 2016 – 2020

● **Marsannay Les Longeroies**

This is quite a plump wine, with sweet slow and damson fruit flavours and a subtle menthol characteristic. Very good freshness with tightly integrated tannins, this is long and very appealing. Drink 2017 – 2023

A fine feeling of richness, from this somewhat overlooked appellation bordering Gevrey Chambertin. Whilst never quite as sophisticated, it is always a style which gives lots of pleasure, for earlier drinking and this is a fine example. Drink 2017 – 2024

Arnaud's policy of 100% destemming his fruit, makes for a wine of real purity and brightness. With hints of brambles and spice, there is an excellent texture, making it extremely rewarding indeed. Drink 2017 – 2025

● **Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Champeaux (very limited)**

£495.00 per 6 Bottles In Bond

This lovely 1er Cru makes a wonderfully pleasurable style of wine. It is so giving with its rich flavours of black fruits and natural sweetness. There is a lovely uplifting feel on the finish, with a crisp bright freshness. Drink 2018 – 2027

● **Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Lavaux St Jacques (very limited)**

£545.00 per 6 Bottles In Bond

A very rounded and complete wine. This has an excellent drive of freshness that one expects from this vineyard, positioned on the higher slopes of the appellation, but is also layered, with a hugely complex melange of wild fruit flavours. Very long and very sophisticated. Drink 2018 – 2029

● **Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru (very limited)**

This is a very rounded style and surprisingly seductive for a Clos de Vougeot. Slightly less masculine than some wine that one finds in the Clos, it is an absolute beauty, with its silky tannins, freshness of acidity and long classy finish. Drink 2018 – 2029

The basis for the success of this fine Domaine has been about hard graft and dedication. Started by Christian's father, a Polish immigrant who landed in Gevrey-Chambertin in the 1930s, the house and cellars which we visit today were built by father and son in the 1950s. Following fifty years of extraordinary success as

winemakers, the family tradition is being continued by the girls in the family with his daughter and niece firmly at the helm. Their style is to make powerfully intense wines with a healthy proportion of new oak which Christian has always felt aids and enhances the brilliance of Pinot Noir flavours.

● **Bourgogne Rouge**

Deliciously approachable, with easy damson fruit flavours, a subtle tannic structure and open freshness. Classically Pinot in every way. Drink 2017 – 2021

Often this cuvée can be a little reserved when tasted from cask, but at the time of tasting in November it was quite fabulous. Generous, giving, full of rich plentiful dark fruits, fresh and lively, all in all a very appealing style. Drink 2017 – 2023

A more structured and powerfully intense style than the straight village wine. This will require a little more patience, but with its firm grippy intensity this will be a very fine Gevrey in 6–8 years. Drink 2018 – 2025

The closest 1er Cru before reaching the village from the south, this is powerful and intense with strong flavours of liquorice and black fruits. With masses of concentration, this is a good muscular style with weight and depth. Drink 2018 – 2026

Just below Grand Cru Clos St Denis, this is one of Morey St Denis's finest 1er Crus. Deep intense purple colour, this has a lovely juicy generosity of vibrant wild fruits. Tremendous volume, with a mouth coating finish of vanilla oak. Drink 2017 – 2025

● **Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Fonteny**

Just above his 1er Cru Corbeaux lying at the top end of the village, Fonteny always has a dark brooding characteristic to it. This is full, rich and wonderfully concentrated. A wine with both great texture and potential. Drink 2018 – 2027

A flagship 1er Cru, from the higher slopes above the village by Clos St Jacques. Whilst superbly rich and full, it always has a silky refined texture, with great levels of purity and drive. This is a superb wine, with a lovely sensuous, creamy finish. Drink 2018 – 2027

● **Charmes Chambertin Grand Cru (limited)**

£355.00 per 3 Bottles In Bond

Strong rich smoky coffee bean aromas. The dense dark opaque colour follows into the palate, with black wild forest fruit flavours. A superbly composed wine, with great breadth and a hugely fine long intense finish. Drink 2018 – 2030

With one of the most picturesque gardens and beautiful château in the Côte de Nuits, it is little wonder that this fine estate caught the eye of Bernard Arnaud at LVMH, already proprietors of Châteaux Cheval Blanc and Yquem in Bordeaux. The purchase took place in the summer of this year, but it is very much business as normal with the wonderfully personable Thierry Brouin remaining at the helm and imparting all his 35 years of experience at the estate in the vineyard management and wine making.

● **Morey St Denis (limited)**

Radiant scarlet in colour, full of crisp currant fruit aromas and flavours. This is lively and fresh, and will give youthful Pinot Noir pleasure. Drink 2018 – 2025

In 2013 Thierry says their whole bunch winemaking philosophy played a huge part in the success of their wines. He explained that the potassium in the stalks absorbs a higher level of acidity which helps create stylish wines. These are also wines with a hint of sweetness that can sometimes be lacking this year.

● **Clos des Lambrays Grand Cru (limited)**

£345.00 per 3 Bottles In Bond

A wine which exemplifies the charms and complexities of whole bunch pressed fruit. This wine has a softness of touch with delicate acidity for the vintage, with layered sweet wild strawberry flavours. Long, refined and Grand Cru in every way. Drink 2018 – 2030

DOMAINE LOUIS BOILLOT, Chambolle Musigny

The secret to the success of his 2013s, according to Louis, was the very gentle handling of the fruit during the winemaking process. A slight simplification I am sure, as Louis is also very much a man of the soil and he would have made sure that the best fruit that the year could offer was initially brought in, but I suspect he takes it for granted that any grower worth

his weight would do this. What he means is that in a late harvesting year, with lower levels of alcohol and finer fruit flavours, it is vital not to over-extract a false tannic structure. This is a year when gentle fermentation allows the true flavours of Pinot Noir and the wines' origins (i.e. appellation) to express themselves. Louis's wines really hit the spot in 2013.

● **Volnay Les Grands Poisots**

£245.00 per 12 Bottles In Bond

A superb Volnay wine, in what for many growers was a difficult vintage in this appellation. A fine balance between crisp croquant red fruits and subtle silky tannins. A wine of grace and charm with a delicious finish. Drink 2017 – 2025

● **Gevrey Chambertin Les Evocelles**

£390.00 per 12 Bottles In Bond

This superbly positioned lieu dit at the top of the slopes of Gevrey Chambertin always produces a very fine Gevrey. A bright and lively style with very defined bright red fruit flavours. Long, pure and complex. Drink 2018 – 2027

● **Gevrey Chambertin**

A little reserved on the nose, this has an almost Chambollesque touch to it. A wine of real harmony and charm with a beautiful soft sweetness of fruit on the finish. A lovely wine. Drink 2017 – 2025

● **Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Champonnets**

£475.00 per 12 Bottles In Bond

Full flavours of damsons and sloes, this is a very appealing style with a broad mouth coating texture. It is full and intense, with a subtle grainy tannic character. This is a wine that represents the power of Gevrey balanced with an elegant subtlety. Drink 2018 – 2028

● **Chambolle Musigny**

£330.00 per 12 Bottles In Bond

A fine balance between crisp red cherry and rounded Morello cherry flavours. The nose is full of scented red fruits, but in the palate a weight of substance comes through to give the wine strength and intensity. Long and full with good rounded tannins. Drink 2017 – 2025



Husband and wife Louis Boillot and Ghislaine Barthod make a great team. Whilst they vinify their wines separately, but at the same family winery in Chambolle Musigny it is hardly surprising that their wines share a very similar ethos and style. Purity and vineyard representation has always been the hallmark of the

Barthod label and Ghislaine loves years such as 2013; the later ripening seasons really allow the appellations and origins of the fruit to speak for themselves amongst her differing individual parcels. This is a fine range showing the true characteristics of all her vineyard sites in this wonderful village.

- **Bourgogne Rouge**

£185.00 per 12 Bottles In Bond

Always a favourite of mine and everything Bourgogne Rouge should. Vibrant and lively with charming raspberry Pinot Noir fruit flavours. A wine which jumps out of the glass and asks to be drunk! Drink 2016 – 2021

- **Chambolle Musigny**

£198.00 per 6 Bottles In Bond

There is never anything complicated about Ghislaine's Chambolle Musigny. Chambolle should focus on charm and bright red fruits, with a soft silky touch and delicate volume. This wine is as benchmark as it gets and has amazing harmony. Lovely. Drink 2017 – 2025

- **Chambolle Musigny 1er Cru Les Gruenchers (limited)**

£345.00 per 6 Bottles In Bond

Almost impossible to pronounce, "gruenchers" is the name for a small walnut. This has a raspberry coulis aroma. It is a wine possessing beautiful harmony, with rounded fruit tannins and pretty flavours of blueberries and mulberries. Lovely and sweet on the finish. Drink 2018 – 2027

- **Chambolle Musigny 1er Cru Les Chatelots (limited)**

£345.00 per 6 Bottles In Bond

The most central vineyard in the appellation, this has a strong bright red currant scent and a tightly integrated style, between crisp fruit tannins and fine purity. A wine with great life and energy. Drink 2018 – 2027

- **Chambolle Musigny 1er Cru Beaux Bruns (limited)**

£345.00 per 6 Bottles In Bond

Stunning dark wild berry fruits on the nose, a wine with real drive. This is intense and full with lovely clarity of fruit and good depth on the finish. Drink 2018 – 2028

- **Chambolle Musigny 1er Cru Les Cras (very limited)**

£365.00 per 6 Bottles In Bond

A wine of huge class and poise; the higher slopes of Les Cras produce lower yields but fruit of real concentration and intensity. This is a hugely successful 2013, with power, purity and precision. Long lasting potential. Drink 2018 – 2030

In such a short space of time (just 5 years) Alain Hudelot's grandson Charles van Canneyt has achieved a remarkable amount. With an extraordinary collection of some of the finest vineyards in the Côte d'Or the name Hudelot-Noellat has needed little introduction, but Charles, having grown up in Champagne, has arrived with an enthusiasm and hunger to succeed. Having initially been under the watchful eye of

grandfather and wine maker Vincent Mugnier, the 2013s are very much his own and they are as fine a selection in the Côte d'Or as one can find. With the use of 20% of stalks during the fermentation process for all the cuvées (apart from the Bourgogne Rouge) his wines balance a brilliance of bright fruit characters with a lovely hint of sweetness and refinement. This is a delicious selection.

● **Bourgogne Rouge**

£125.00 per 12 Bottles In Bond

Bright ruby red, this is a fresh clean and vibrant Pinot from vineyards surrounding Vougeot. Deliciously forward, with a fresh lively finish. Drink 2016 – 2022

● **Chambolle Musigny**

£310.00 per 12 Bottles In Bond

Whilst closed on the nose, this has a lovely rounded generous mouthfeel. The supple sweet loganberry fruits are supported by a soft silky tannic structure. This is tremendously pure and fine on the finish. Drink 2017 – 2025

Côte de Nuits. Whilst his Vosne wines need little introduction and are exceptional as always, it was his wines from Nuits St Georges this year that really caught my eye. It is fair to say that they were absolutely buzzing with a brilliance of fruit and real vibrancy; Etienne has made an exceptional range in 2013.

with this vintage. It is a testament to his legacy that the extreme quality to which he always aspired, amongst all the appellations has been maintained. Volumes are down substantially as a result of the summer hailstorms, but what little quantity there is, is of very fine quality indeed.

2013 produced the smallest crop in the memory of the current members of the de Nicolay family. A normal year's production at the domaine is 200 casks and in 2013 it was a pitiful 50! In Greek times, they would say the Gods did not look kindly upon the village of Savigny this year; the cool spring and flowering season already meant yields would be

low, but then then the hailstorm at the end of July ravaged certain vineyards. Consequently there is no Savigny Lavières this year with the equivalent of only 3 casks in comparison to a normal 20. What they have produced though is not only the result of very small yields, but also extraordinary intrinsic levels of concentration and great class.

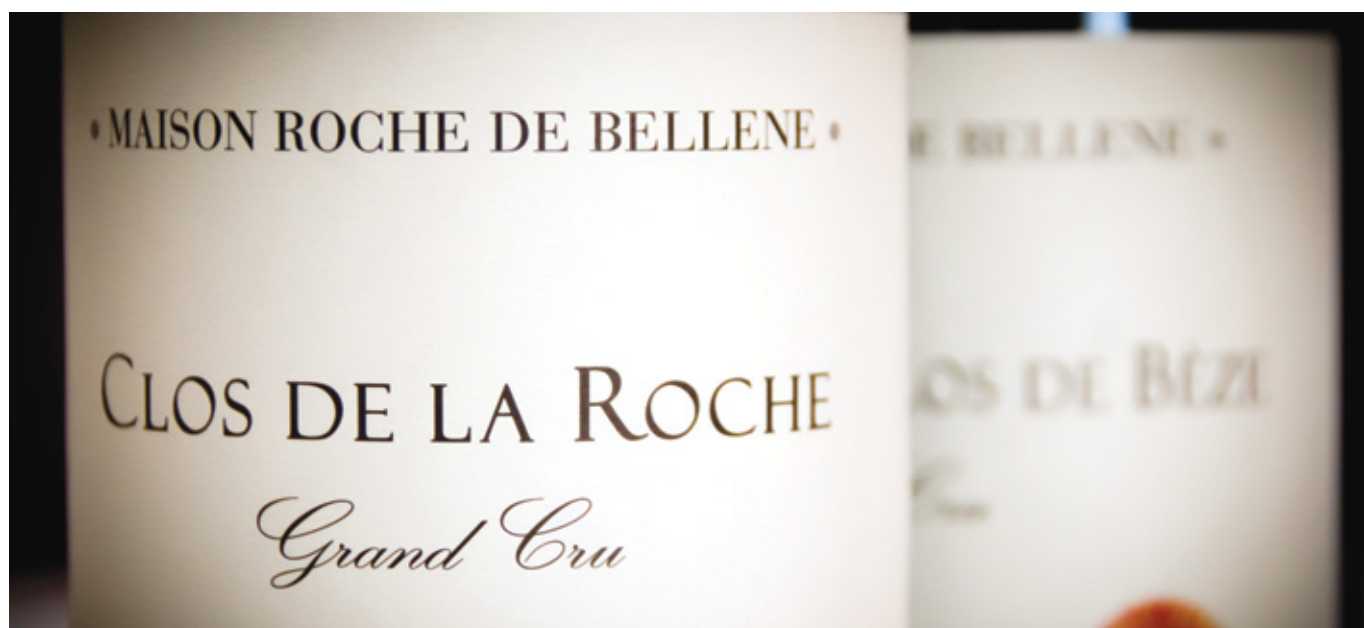

Whilst 2013 is not a large crop, the yields are a

little greater than their very small 2012 harvest. Gerard Boudot is extremely optimistic of the quality positioning the wines in style between 2012 and 2011; thus they have the weight and density of a 2012 with a little bite of acidity that the 2011s retained. Whilst nobody really keeps white Burgundy today for the long term, these will produce very good mature wines.

He does not like making wines of excess and therefore uses minimal amounts of new oak (15%) and likes to leave the wines in stainless steel vats for their second winter before bottling, to preserve the primary fruit characteristics to a maximum. The result is always wines with a beautiful touch of minerality and great purity and there is no better vintage to show off this style than 2013. *Please note: his 1er Crus are released later in the Spring.*

2013 is a vintage which accentuates Jacques style of wine making. The natural purity and refined fruit flavours are really enhanced by this vintage. Bouchard Ainé with a responsibility for their 30 hectares in the appellation of Mercurey, hence nobody understands the appellation and the variety of soil types better. Over the years he has selected his favourite vineyard parcels showcasing the differing styles within the village to build up the family domaine. This is a stunning address and highlights both the quality and potential for the wines from the area.

● **Mercurey Vieilles Vignes**
