


Stair Riser Installation Guide

You will need:

General purpose kitchen cleaner & a sponge A pencil A cutter or pair of scissors A soft cloth



Apply to a clean, dry surface & non porous surface. Painted surfaces must be a satin or gloss paint as matte paint repels the adhesive.




Once the strip is in place work from the middle outwards. You are trying not to trap any air bubbles in the vinyl. Press the strip edge outwards towards the stair edge. Now continue with the other half. Using the cloth sweep left to right & continue until the entire strip is down. Press over the edges to ensure a firm adhesion. Work the vinyl to the staircase edge as best you can. Trim edges with a cutter for a perfect fit.

Tip: - Strips can be joined for longer lengths seamlessly.



Mark the centre of a strip with a pencil. Also mark the centre of the stair decal. Peel back half of the backing paper to the centre mark, align to the centre of the riser & butt the top edge to the stair riser.



Repeat steps 2 & 3 until all the risers are in place & the pattern flows uniformly. Leave the new surface to cure 24 hours before returning to normal activity. Do not wash or moisten the strips until 24 hours have past.
