This year I was listening to a sermon and the Pastor said: "God is a God of order". Meaning God honors order and He will do exactly what He said He'll do. When we declare to God what He has said, the very words He has spoken in the Bible, He will listen and He will answer our prayers. That's why it is important to know the word of God. Have your head in the good book. Learn from the lessons, trials, and victories in the Bible. The more we read the Bible, the more we understand the character of God and draw closer to Him.

Before, I used to view God as a high, almighty Savior who is far beyond my understanding. But now I know exactly who He is. He is our Creator who loves us so deeply. He shows us time and time again with His unfailing love that forgives, protects and strengthens us. He shows us in the Bible how He chose imperfect people to lead huge movements. He chose Israel who kept turning their back on Him. Who only but our Creator can love such a mess and see strength, leadership, and beauty.

Each morning on my way taking my children to school, I declare in my prayer, "God you said you'll never leave us, nor forsake us... I'm asking that you provide a shield of protection around the school, around my children and every student, teacher and staff..."

1. Deuteronomy 31:8 NIV
