This writing book is CAPS compliant and the pupils learn to write on the

17mm lines as specified.

The letters appear in the following sequence:

Even page numbers: The pupils learn to write a letter of the alphabet by writing between the lines and writing over the letters and words.

They recognize and identify small and capital etters.

Odd page numbers:

The pupils practise writing the letters and words on the 17mm lines.

The activities also re-inforce the following skills:

Fine motor co-ordination: writing skills

Visual discrimination.


Spatial relations.

Recognition and identification of capital and small letters.

PLEASE NOTE: this is NOT a phonics book but a handwriting one, and the words used are relevant to the letter of the alphabet taught and not the sounds they make.

Follow the arrows and trace over the letter with your fingers. Then use different coloured crayons to write the letter. Stay between the lines.





Write over all the letters. Use one colour for the lower

case letters and a different colour for the capital letters.

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
