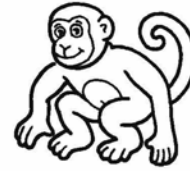


# CONTENTS



## Pages 1 - 52

Learning to write each letter of the alphabet, in both capital and small letters. Practising the way to write each letter and copying letters and sentences.

The following skills are also re-inforced:

Fine motor co-ordination

Visual discrimination

Spatial relations

Recognition and identification of capital and small letters.

Learners can learn about and identify the different parts of speech and punctuation marks in the sentences and paragraphs.

The letters of the alphabet are in alphabetical order but can be taught in any order.

The children can either:

first learn to write each letter of the alphabet and then do the words and sentences afterwards OR they do the words and sentences simultaneously when they do that specific letter of the alphabet.

## Pages 53 - 56

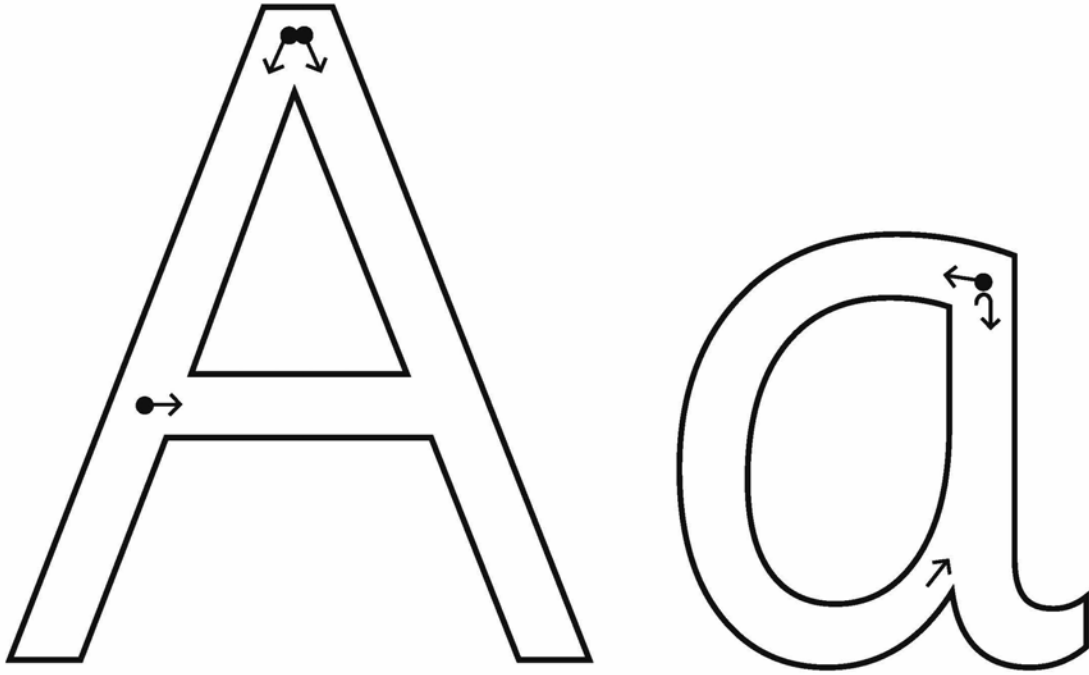
