

# CHRISTMAS TREE

## *decorating guide*

### Fairy Lights

More is better when it comes to lighting your tree. Trust us! A tip is to use at least two sets of lights so you can have some on steady burn, and others on twinkle. This will give you a subtle twinkle without the twinkle becoming too much to look at.

When placing the lights on your tree, start at the bottom right of your tree and move in a clockwise direction, weaving the lights in and out of the branches as you go. When you get to the other side of the tree, start the next row 15-20cm above the last row and head back around the tree in the other direction. If you use the tip suggested above, you need to alternate each row of lights so you end up with an even coverage of lights.

### Ribbon & Bows

If you're using bows, place these evenly throughout your tree in a diamond pattern. This will ensure you have even coverage. If you're having a bow at the top of your tree, it's at this point you should also add this.

If you're wanting to use strips of ribbon, place them evenly around the tree at different angles.

### Baubles

The purpose of these baubles is to be a cheaper way to fill your tree. The type of bauble doesn't matter too much, but we recommend you have 3 different sized baubles (6cm, 8cm, and 10cm). If you can find larger baubles (15-20cm), don't be scared to use them - it will look amazing! If you have a 9ft tree or taller, then the 15-20cm size baubles are a non-negotiable.

When placing the baubles, place all the larger ones evenly towards the bottom 2/3-1/2 of the tree, then move to the medium size baubles and place them throughout the entire tree. Lastly, place the smallest baubles throughout the tree as well.

### Florals & Sprays

Place your feature flowers evenly throughout your tree by continuing to follow the diamond pattern to help with even coverage. Once that's done, place your filler sprays.

The filler sprays don't have to be perfectly spaced, as they are just there to help fill the tree, and create visual texture and depth. Just make sure they look as natural as possible. This means not leaving them flat like they've just come out of a box - spread and bend the branches.

### Special Ornaments & Keepsakes

Now you can add the special/feature ornaments and your keepsakes throughout your tree. Lastly, if you prefer a more traditional tree topper, such as a star or angel, now is the time to finish off your tree by placing it at the top of your tree.
