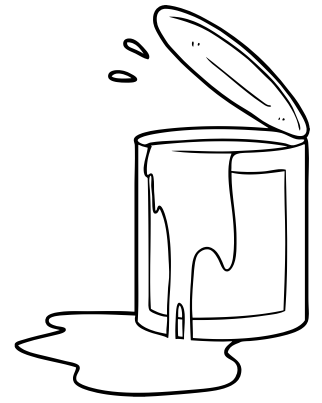


# SUPPLY LIST



For "Home is Where the Heart Is" - a fun size mixed media workshop with artist Christina Lovisa

**Wooden house shapes.** I used small sections of 2'x4' with a peak roof cut. If you can't get someone to cut your wood for you, just use any old wood scraps - your roofs will be flat :-)

**Photocopies or prints** (no originals) of your favourite people and things scaled to fit your houses.

**Glue for paper** - modpodge or thinned white glue or wallpaper paste

**Chalk paints** (I use Colorantic see [acuratednest.com](http://acuratednest.com)) or any acrylic or water based paints. Craft paints will do nicely. NOTE: If you want to add encaustic wax afterwards, you should use chalk or clay based paints. Faux encaustic will work over top of acrylic.

**Tools** - small paint brushes, water bucket, knife or scissors, pencils, sanding block or sandpaper, favourite mark making tools etc...

**Fine collage papers** such as napkins and tissue papers with patterns and colours you like & metallic leaf.

**Faux Encaustic** - Gloss water-based varnish or medium. Paste wax clear. At A Curated Nest we carry Triple Thick gloss and paste wax by Colorantic.

**Real Encaustic** - Encaustic medium: beads are easiest if you're new to encaustic (white - which is clear when thin) and a wax iron (no holes and holds a low temp).

**An embossing gun** or heat gun helps smooth out any iron ridges.
