To whom it may concern,


I have just seen a demonstration of a product designed by Bill Harris. This product is a bowl designed to make it easier for brachycephalic (smushed faced) dogs/cats, or dogs/cats with dental issues/tongue issues to prehend food.

For years I have watched the "flat faced" dogs and cats struggle to get food out of bowls and end up with it all over their faces. Bill's dog Lacey who is a French Bulldog gave us a demonstration. The bowl allows food to roll down to a spot that makes it easier for her to get it and as well provides a slope for her to push against and prevents food from getting stuck in "corners".

I feel there is a definite market for such a product, especially for brachycephalic breeds of dogs and cats. I also think this may help dogs that have had jaw surgeries such as mandibulectomies.
