

VLA26 VEGA CHAIR

VILHELM LAURITZEN

DESCRIPTION

Designed in the 1950s, the reissued chair is a modernist masterpiece. Profiling Vilhelm Lauritzen's signature aesthetic, the functionalist design appears effortlessly simple yet is imbued with character. Well-proportioned for comfort, its back curves to embrace the sitter. Expertly crafted in wood and steel, optional upholstery on the seat and back up the comfort level while elegant wooden feet lend an artisanal feel to the stackable design.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

Steel frame is bended and welded. Wooden backrest is steam bent and processed on a CNC machine.

DESIGNER

Vilhelm Theodor Lauritzen was one of Denmark's most important architects and a father of Danish Modernism. Today, many of his projects remain as lasting examples of what was then a new and revolutionary approach to architecture in which form followed function. Throughout his career, he maintained that architecture should be an applied art that serves all, not just the privileged few.

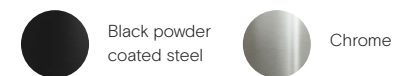
