









Connect seat back with seat base
Remove the four pre-installed M8
bolts from the backrest using the 8mm
Allen key. Align the backrest and the
rear of the seat base carefully according
to the picture.

Secure back onto the seat via the loose support bracket before the tight one.

Secure seat back with seat base
Use the 8mm Allen key and the previously removed M8 bolts to attach the backrest to the seat base.







Right side cover
Attach the right side cover to the support bracket on the chair. Then fasten the M6 bolts using 6mm Allen key.

Left side cover

Attach the left side cover to the support bracket on the chair. Then fasten the M6 bolts using 6mm Allen key.





Armrest mounting


Attach the armrests, making sure the correct armrests are on their designated side.

Secure the arm rests with the M8 bolts, spring washers and washers supplied. Attach all four of the bolts, spring washers and washers before tightening.

Chair mechanism mounting

Remove the four pre-installed M8 screws with the 8mm Allen key from the bottom of the seat base. Align the chair mechanism according to the posted directions on the bottom of the seat base. Attach the chair mechanism by using the previously removed M8 screws.






Caster wheel, Five-star base, Gas piston and Piston cover Installation Insert the gas lift piston into the five-star base and then slide the piston cover over the gas lift.

Linking the parts


Align and connect the base and chair by inserting the gas piston into the opening on the chair mechanism according to the picture.

Detachable lumbar cushion

Pull the lumbar cushion straps through the backrest openings from front to back according to the picture. Connect both buckles from the bottom and top of the backrest to secure and adjust the lumbar cushion.


Detachable headrest cushion

Pull the headrest cushion straps through the backrest openings according to the picture. Connect the buckle to secure the headrest cushion.



Seat backrest adjustment


Pull the handle on the right side of the seat and lean backwards to tilt the backrest into the desired position. Lock the position by releasing the handle.



Seat height adjustment

Pull up the handle underneath the right side of seat base to adjust the seat height and then lock it by releasing the handle.


Rocking feature


On the small mechanism, pull out the handle on the right side of the seat base to enable the rocking feature.

On the large mechanism, flip the paddle on the left side of the seat base up to enable the rocking feature. To lock your position, flip the paddle back down until the desired position is reached. 4

Adjustment of rocking feature

Turn the knob underneath the seat base left and right to adjust the tension of the rocking mechanism.


Vertical adjustment


Pull the handle up and down to the desired height. Release the handle to lock the height according to preference.



Horizontal adjustment

Press and hold the middle button to move the armrest horizontally. Release the button to lock the position according to preference.





Front to back adjustment
Hold the front button to move the armrest back and forth. Release the button to lock the position according to preference.

Rotating adjustment

The armrest can be rotated inwards and outwards without the use of a button.
