PEPEROMIA KOKEDAMA

Native to the West Indies and South America, this is a hardy trailing plant that grows in warm conditions and enjoys ample water. Wild in nature it grows as an epiphyte on trees and ground cover on the forest floor.



TEMPERAMENT: Grows well in 65°F - 75°F temperatures.



LIGHT: Prefers medium-to-low direct sunlight.



WATER: Weekly. Submerge ¾ of the kokedama in water in a glass or metal bowl for 10 -15 minutes or whenever the ball feels light and dry. Gently squeeze out excess water and place back in the saucer.



PET FRIENDLY: Yes.



AIR CLEANING: Peperomias are particularly good at getting rid of formaldehyde.



SIGNS OF DISTRESS:

Droopy leaves, mushy stems, and moldy soil The plant is over watered. Remove the damaged bits and dry out the soil.
